DIPLOMA TYPES, WEIGHTED GRADES, & CLASS RANK

LPS offers three diploma types – Silver, Gold, and Platinum – and offers a weighted GPA for all Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Credit (DC) classes. Additionally, LPS requires all students to earn at least one Market Value Asset (MVA) prior to graduation.

Platinum diploma earners attain the maximum of 28 credits and earn 2 MVAs. Gold diploma earners attain the LPS standard of 25.5 credits and earn 1 MVA. Silver diploma earners attain the state minimum of 24 credits and earn 1 MVA.

Students receive an additional 1.0 point to reflect the grades they earn in AP and DC classes: A=5.0, B=4.0, C=3.0, D=2.0, F=0.0

While class rank and academic honors are based on an unweighted 4.0 GPA scale, a weighted GPA is calculated for all students as well.

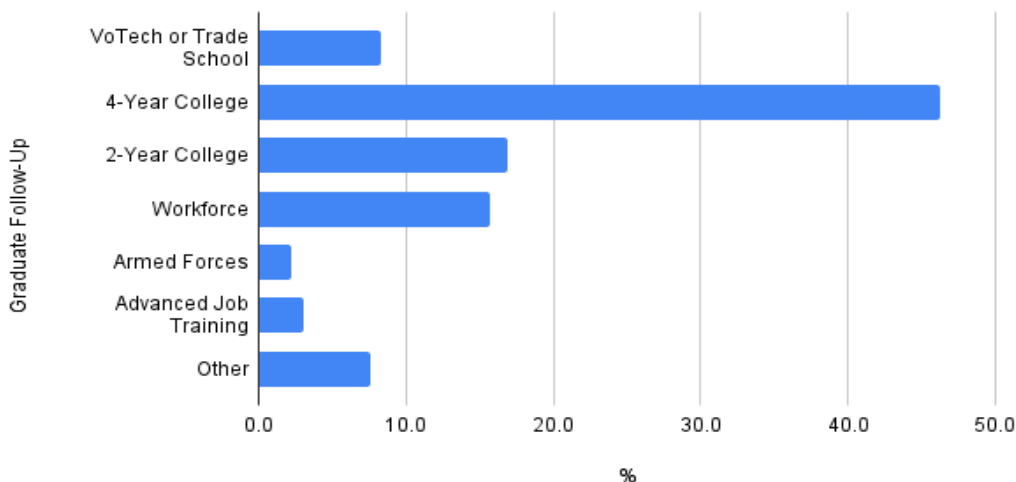
