



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Ways to Include WTEF in Your Planning

If you're 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ or older, this is a tax-smart way to make a gift to WTEF while decreasing your taxable income. If you are 72 or older, these gifts will also help meet your Required Minimum Distribution.

In planning for charitable giving during life, gifts of appreciated assets are tax-smart assets to contribute to WTEF. Giving appreciated stock, bonds, or mutual funds to support WTEF may provide you with a charitable income tax deduction while also avoiding capital gains tax liability.

Naming WTEF as the beneficiary of a retirement account, insurance policy, or bank or brokerage account may offer significant tax benefits and is easy to update should your plans change in the future.

One of the simplest ways to create a legacy with WTEF is in your will or trust. You can leave a specific amount, percentage, all, or a portion of the remainder of your estate to the program or school that is meaningful to you.


