**Football:** Football is coming off of an amazing upset win over a section-leading 5-1 Hamburg team last Friday night. This win gives us a 4-3 record this season. Football will take on Annville Cleona tonight for our last home game of the season. Tonight will be senior night for all football, cheer, and band members who will be honored throughout the evening.

**Boys Soccer:** Boys Soccer ended the season with an 8-4-4 record. They are currently sitting in the final 8<sup>th</sup> spot for the district playoffs.
