- 7-7.5 hours/day

BASIC REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have at least a high school diploma or its equivalent.
- Must be at least 18 years old to serve students in Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 8.
- Must have either a short-term or full paraprofessional license.

SHORT-TERM PARAPROFESSIONAL APPROVAL:

- Available for application until June 30, 2025.
- Valid for three fiscal years.
- Cannot be renewed.
- Must be at least 18 years old to serve in Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 8.
- While working on short-term approval, must be fulfilling requirements for the full license.

FULL PARAPROFESSIONAL LICENSE

- Valid five fiscal years.
- May be renewed with payment of registration fees.
- Must be at least 19 years old to serve in Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 12.
- One of the following is required:
 - Associate's degree or higher
 - 60 semester hours of coursework
 - High school diploma or GED and a score of 460 or higher on the ETS Parapro Assessment
 - High school diploma or GED and the following scores on the ACT Workkeys Assessment
 - Applied Mathematics/Applied Math - 4 or above
 - Reading for Information/Workplace Documents - 4 or above
- Must work under the direct supervisions of a licensed teacher.
- Fully licensed paraprofessionals with bachelor's degrees on file also qualify to serve as substitute teachers.
