Each year, schools utilize a variety of screening tools to help staff determine which students may be academically or behaviorally healthy and those "at risk". These screenings can include recent results of state or district tests as well as specific academic or behavior screening tests; these screening assessments are typically administered to all students two or three times per year. In the Unified School District of De Pere, the universal screening tools used in math are a 1:1 screening assessment (K-2) and iReady Math (3-4). The universal screening tools in reading are aimswebPlus (K-3) and iReady (3-4). Click here to read about our District's behavior health screening tool which will be used in October.

What Makes a Lunch?

As a way to cut down on food waste in our schools and to encourage students to try new foods, we would like to clarify what actually constitutes a reimbursable meal. Many students and families have been under the impression that students must take all five components of a school lunch when in reality students are only required to take three out of the five components that are offered. We're hoping that by spreading the word about this, students won't take food that they don't have any intention of eating, therefore cutting down on our overall food waste as a district. Additionally, we're hoping that more students will feel comfortable trying our school lunch if they know they don't have to take everything that's on the menu.
