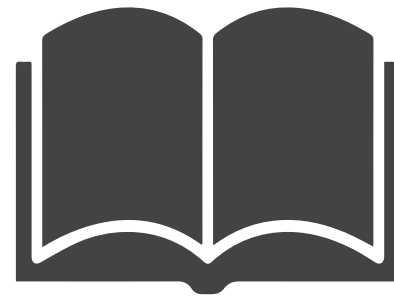

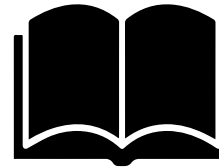


Dinuba Unified School District ranks near the top of similar districts in the State for CAASPP performance

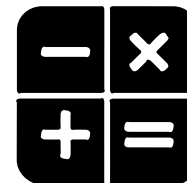

Below are some of the reasons for our improvement.

- ❑ DUSD committed to vertical articulation in the 7-12 English department.
- ❑ DUSD is continuing its focus on phonics and phonemic awareness instruction in the early grades.
- ❑ DUSD implemented a series of Math lesson labs.
- ❑ DUSD is piloting Building Thinking Classrooms with a small group of 3-12 Math teachers.
- ❑ DUSD made changes to school testing calendars.
- ❑ DUSD made some revisions to middle school math pacing and assessment to address more content.
- ❑ DUSD joined 8/9 On Track Collaboration to support improved high school A-G completion.

In summary:

- ❑ **DUSD** ranks near the top of 30 demographically similar districts in California for both Math and ELA.
- ❑ **DUSD** is #1 in ELA and Math for Tulare County.
- ❑ **DUSD** ranks highly when compared to Fresno County as well.
