


National Custodian Appreciation Day October 2nd

Explicitly teaching writing






Good Writers...







Over 20 HLPUSD students toured the campus and received resources to support their educational journey including information about admission, financial aid and specialized programs.








La Puente High School Professional Dance CTE Pathway


