ACADEMICS

Metrolina Christian provides a robust curriculum and instruction program throughout each division in the academy. The program is anchored in the following:

- Intentionality to developing a Biblical Worldview in all students which is developmentally appropriate and reflective of the Word of God.
- Differentiated instruction which mirrors the learning preferences and needs of diverse learners.
- Engaged and interactive classrooms which tap into the inquisitive nature of learners.
- Cross-curricular and collaborative instruction which provides application, analysis, and synthesis of skills and concepts to extend the learning.

The beauty of MCA's curriculum and instruction program is that it is set in a nurturing and loving environment which in lower school supports young minds as they investigate all content areas and discover a love for reading, math, science, social studies, or Bible which will set the pace for a lifelong pursuit. The middle school setting and culture understands the season of supporting students as they walk through great intellectual, physical, social, and emotional growth and development where cultivating strong leadership skills is foundational.

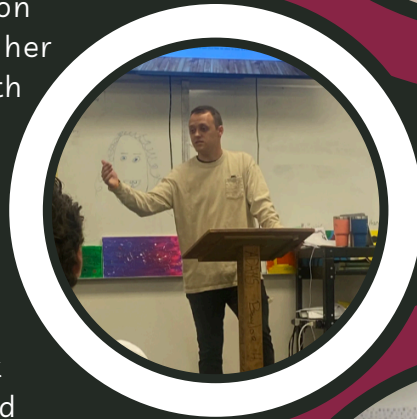
HANNAH WALKER, CLASS OF 2016

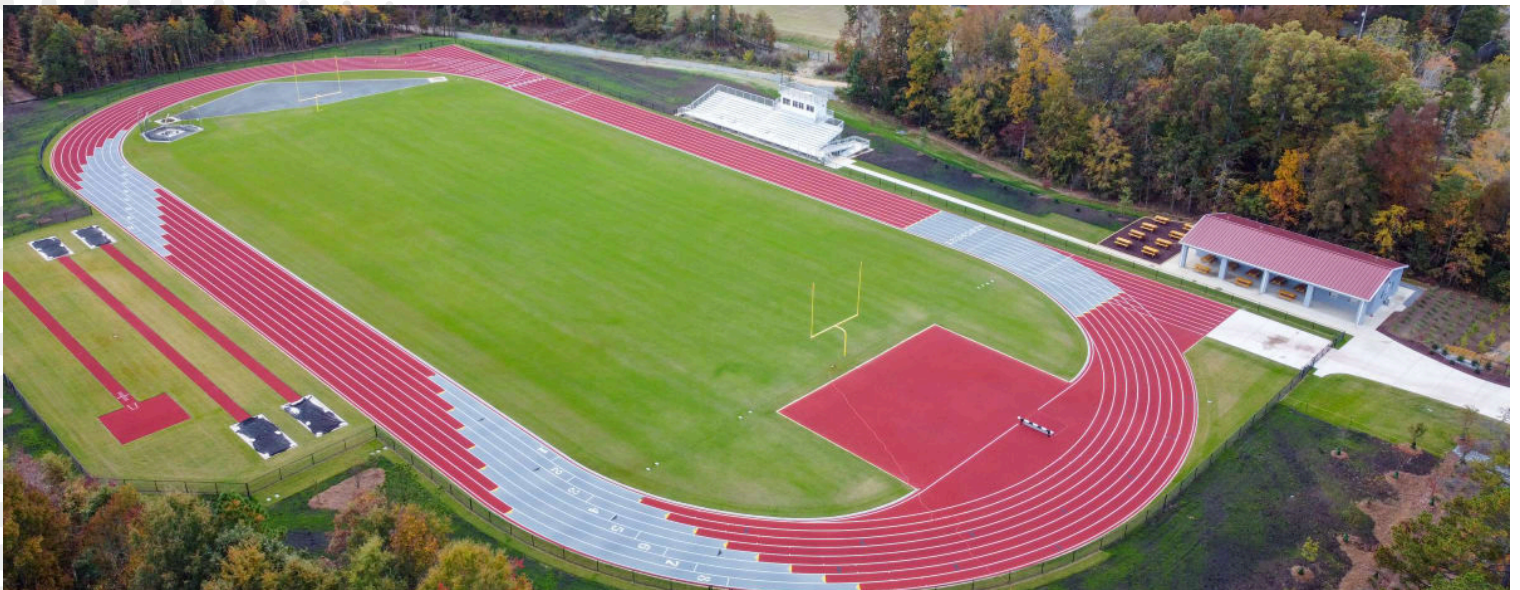


TRACK & FIELD COMPLEX

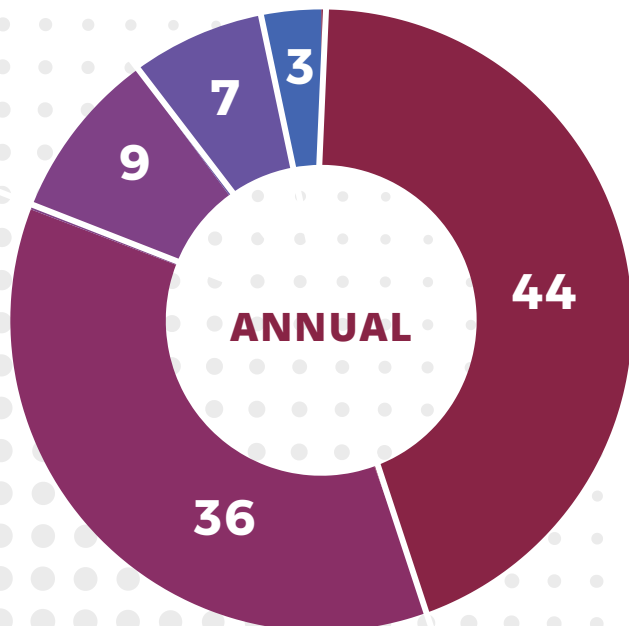
FROM OUR ADVANCEMENT TEAM
