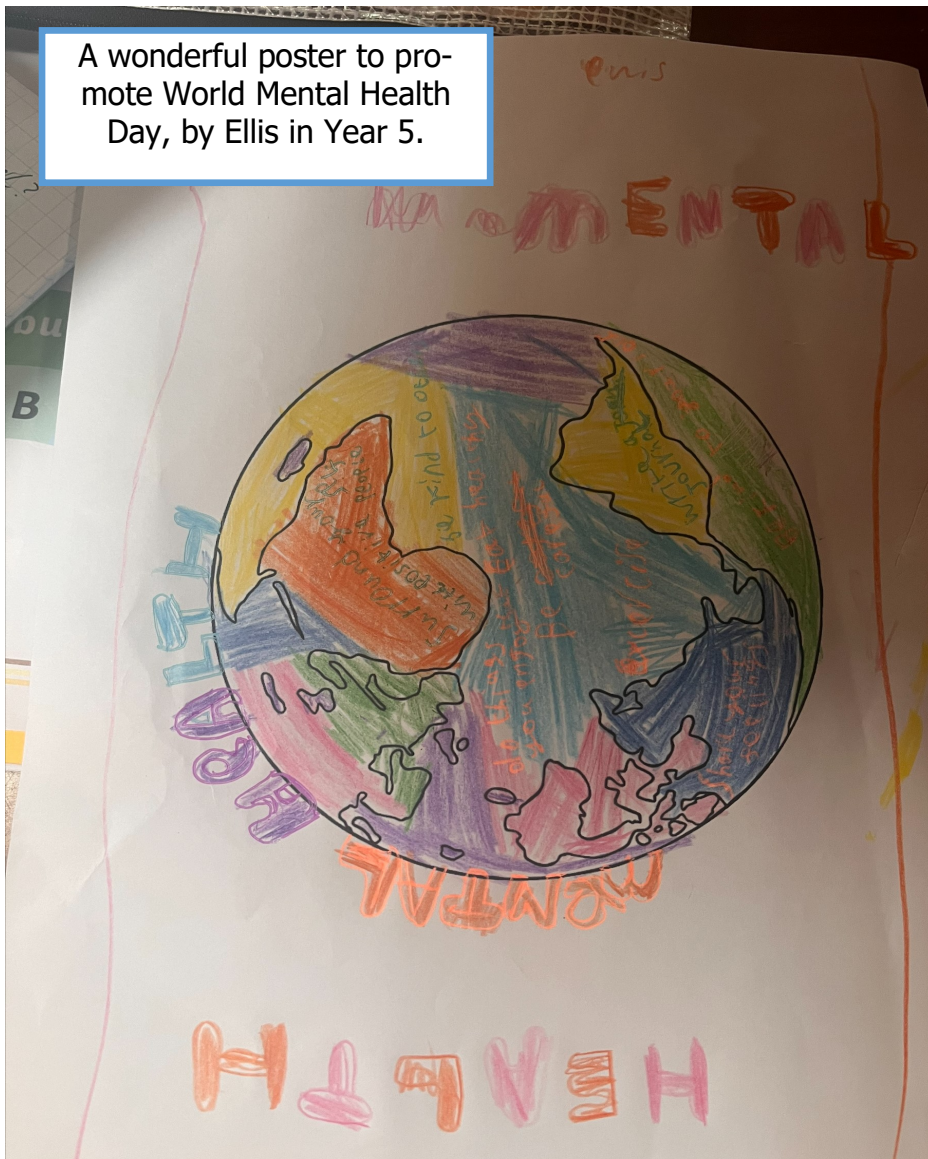
Welcome!
