October 1, 2024

The meeting was called to order by Susan Fogliano at 6:02 PM.

- I. Architect and Construction Manager Update
 - Scott Scholl from Downes Construction provided a Preconstruction project update which began with itemizing Value Engineering HVAC Savings that were captured at Center, Middle and Lyme Schools due to reviewing bid items and resulted in items that could be eliminated and items that had to remain. (Please refer to the attached document for informational purposes only).
 - MOTION: Alan Sheiness made a motion and seconded by Andy Russell to approve the Value Engineering solutions at Center, Middle, and Lyme Schools.

VOTE: The committee voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

An update on the results of re-bidding the General Trades packages was presented which realized a savings of \$251,079 at Center, Middle, and Lyme Schools.

At the September 16th committee meeting five scenarios were reviewed in order to bring the project within budget. Through scope reductions and savings from the re-bids, the project is currently \$119,612 under budget.

The next item discussed was the completion of the security vestibules for all three HVAC Schools (Lyme, Middle and Center). Mrs. Fogliano explained to the committee of the potential for the security vestibules to be managed and completed concurrently with the project under a separate

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contract with DCC.

Mr. Scholl reviewed the attachment of three Letters of Authorization outlining each scope of work and their bid costs for HVAC for ALL Bids. The building committee is tasked to review, vote on and bring to the Board of Ed for final approval in order to permit Downes to release the Notice to Proceed to the subcontractors to get all three projects started.

MOTION: Alan Sheiness made a motion, that was seconded by Sara Hrinak to recommend to the Board of Education to accept all bids for the PreK-8 project as presented in the attached letters of authorization.

VOTE: The committee voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

Ben Stoner, the project manager for the Mile Creek addition, provided an update on procuring the Switchgear. Due to the lead time in receiving the Switchgear, 2 scenarios were proposed and discussed to provide a temporary Switchgear to feed power to the Mile Creek project in order for construction to begin. Downes is requesting approval to move forward on renting the temporary Switchgear Equipment so that bidding can take place. Contractors bid costs would be affected because of a delay in the install of our own purchased Switchgear.

Mile Creek Phase 2 bidding is underway.

MOTION: A motion was made by Sara Hrinak, and seconded by Tom Kelo that as a concept we recommend to Downes Construction Scenario I for a temporary Switchgear to feed the new addition until the permanent Switchgear arrives.

VOTE: The committee voted unanimously in favor of the motion

The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 PM upon a motion by Tom Kelo and a second by Sara Hrinak.

• There was a total savings of (\$251,079) between rebidding General Trades at all three (3) Schools, (See attached Bid Tab).

C. HVAC Schools Bid Results and Actions

Scenario #4:

Value Management deduct costs for HVAC & Ceilings, remove all Security Vestibule work to be funded through another source, Fire Protection work is removed from Consolidated School and Sitework is removed from all three HVAC Schools. Total Savings of \$4,016,967.

D. Complete of Security Vestibules for All Three HVAC Schools

 Potentially hold current bids for Glass & Glazing and have DCC manage under a separate contract to enable current costs to be held.

E. Letter of Authorization for HVAC Schools for ALL Bids.

F. Mile Creek Phase 1

Temporary Switchgear is being proposed to feed power to the New Addition so this construction can start at the beginning of the project.

- <u>Scenario One</u> Start Addition In December 2024 and rent temporary switchgear to allow for school to occupy new building in October 2025.
 Order of Magnitude cost to install temporary switchgear, rent for 7 months and remove once permanent switchgear arrives is \$165,000.
- <u>Scenario Two</u> Start Addition in May 2025 to coincide with the delivery of the switchgear scheduled for January 2026. Building occupancy will be March 2026.

Estimated Potential Escalation Cost to start addition later: The addition is approximately 36% - 38% of the cost which averages \$965/sf totaling \$8,300,000 x 2% escalation = \$262,500 for six months.
