GIFTED EDUCATION

GIFTED SERVICES

Students who require learning experiences beyond the standard program of instruction will be matched to appropriate gifted services in math and/or reading.

MARYLAND CODE 8-202

“A gifted and talented student needs different services beyond those normally provided by the regular school program in order to develop the student’s potential.”

POTENTIAL STUDENTS

The gifted screening process includes students taking the Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT), gathering of student classroom data and work samples, and information from teachers and parents that is evaluated by a school based committee. Test results and committee decisions will be shared with families at the end of the school year.

STUDENT NOMINATIONS

Parents, Teachers, and students themselves can not nominate a student to be screened for gifted services. The process is started by turning in completed a nomination form. Forms are located on the school website and are due for the 24-25 school year by 10-24-24.
