## CRJS Event Policies and Dress Code

This event is from 6:30 pm-9:00 pm.

- Only students who are in High School may attend this event.
- Doors close at 7:30 p.m. No one will be let in after 7:30 p.m. and no refunds will be provided.
- Students may not leave before 8:45 p.m. Once you leave the event there is no re-entry.
- All attendees must show a valid high school ID to enter.
- All attendees must fill out the parent/guardian contact information in this form for safety and security purposes.
- No substitutions or changing of the names once this form is completed. There are no refunds.
- This event is a CRJS sponsored event, therefore all school regulations and consequences are applicable at this function. CRJS Wolves are responsible for their guests' behavior. Violating these regulations of behavior and safety may result in being dismissed from the event without a refund, parents/guardians will be notified, and/or the police may be called if necessary.
- Behavior must be appropriate for a school-sponsored event. Any persons who do not comply with the requests of CRJS faculty, staff, and/or chaperones may be asked to leave the event without a refund.

### DRESS CODE:

- Casual Wear is permitted for the Homecoming Dance. When deciding what to wear at this event, students must keep in mind the principles of the regular dress code.
- The items listed below are not allowed on the day of the dance:
  - Pants or jeans with holes, tears or frayed edges; low rise or hip hugger pants, jeans, or skirts.
  - Attire with offensive logos (e.g., alcohol, tobacco, sexual innuendos, etc.)
  - Form fitting or tight shirts,
  - Revealing clothing (e.g., tank tops, sleeveless or cap-less sleeve attire, crop tops, halters, off the shoulder or one shoulder, sheer, low-cut, strapless, shorts above the knee, etc.)
  - Any shirt or top that does not provide coverage of the cleavage, midriff, and lower back at all time.
  - Bike, basketball, or knit shorts, stretch pants, leggings, sweatpants, or pajama pants.
  - Head covers including sweatshirt hoods, bandanas, baseball caps, etc.

This is a private event hosted by Cristo Rey Jesuit Seattle. CRJS Administration reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone at this event for any reason they deem necessary. Only current CRJS students and their high school guests who have purchased a ticket and appear on the RSVP list will be allowed admission. Guests at CRJS events must follow the above regulations or they (and/or their school) may not be invited to future events. All CRJS policies will be enforced for all students and their guests.
