Scholarships for Seniors

Promoting student excellence.

- Scholarships for Seniors
 - May 2023, the Foundation awarded 76 scholarships totaling \$70,600 (13% increase from 2022)
 - Since May 2008 we have awarded \$634,125 in scholarships
 - Scholarship Applications for Seniors open on February 1 and close March 1, 2024.
 - Fuel City Crosstown Showdown Raised \$10,000 with a 60/40 split for WEHS and WHS for 2024



Teacher Supply Closet

- August- surveyed WISD teachers
- Received community donations
- Thank you, Wylie ISD for your support – purchasing, maintenance, facilities and so much more!
- Packed and delivered supplies for 1,100 staff in September-October valued at \$36,798
- Continue to provide gift cards and supplies in monthly drawings
- Looking to expand supply closet for 2024-25 school year

Grants for Teachers

The primary purpose of the Wylie ISD Education Foundation is to provide Grants for Teachers.

- November 2023, the Foundation provided 63 grants totaling \$135,862 to 19 campuses (29% increase in grant funds from 2022)
- Since 2002 the Foundation has awarded 662 grants to teachers and campuses totaling \$1,580,900
- Surprise grants coming this spring!

General Endowment Information

We added **7 new Endowments in 2023**. We now have 64 fully funded endowments: **41 scholarships and 23 grants**. The Foundation's investment values increased

The Foundation's endowed annual minimum commitment to Wylie ISD is \$82,750.

- 2023 Boots 'N Barbecue raised over \$341,000 with 750 attendees— this was our highest grossing gala to date, a 55% increase over the previous highest grossing gala in 2022.
 - Over the past 20 years the Gala has raised nearly \$3 million for Grants for Teachers, Scholarships for Seniors, Backpacks for students and the Teacher Supply Closet.
 - Boots 'N Barbecue will be March 23, 2024, at the Plano Event Center
