Attention Parents of 9th-11th Grade Students: Mandatory PSAT Exam on Friday, October 25th

Your child is scheduled to take the mandatory PSAT 8/9 or PSAT/NMSQT exam on **Friday, October 25th.** In preparation for the digital exam, we have been working with students to provide important information about the test and help them get ready. This includes ensuring they have an approved device with the Bluebook app installed. It is the responsibility of each student to arrive on test day with their fully charged device and the Bluebook app ready to go.

If your child has not yet obtained an approved College Board device, please refer to the list of devices below, along with instructions on how to install the Bluebook app.

Please take a moment to check in with your student to ensure they are fully prepared for the exam. The link below helps students identify important information regarding what to do before test day, what to bring on test day and taking the test.

Attention Seniors Taking the Digital SAT at PMA on October 25th!

If your son or daughter is registered to take the SAT at PMA, please review the important details below with your Warrior:

Test Day Instructions:

Arrival Time: Be at school by 7:30 AM and report to the St. Thomas Aquinas Study with all necessary test materials.

What to Bring: An approved, fully charged device with the Bluebook app already downloaded. Important: Testing room doors will close promptly at 7:40 AM. Late arrivals will not be permitted, and no make-up sessions will be available. The test, including pre-administration tasks, will take approximately 3 hours.

Snacks & Water: You may bring a small snack and water to have during the break.

Dress Code:

Students must wear JSS attire with a college shirt/sweatshirt or PMA shirt/polo, along with shoes and socks as outlined in the Parent-Student Handbook. Failure to comply with the dress code may result in being sent home and missing the exam. Please note that exam fees are non-refundable.

SAT Mandatory Digital Readiness Check:

We will host a mandatory Digital Readiness Check session for registered seniors taking the SAT on <u>Thursday, October 17th, from 12:55 PM to 1:30 PM</u> in the St. Thomas Aquinas Study. Students must bring the device they will use on test day, with the Bluebook app already installed.

Prepare for Your Digital SAT:

Ensure your device is ready and the Bluebook app is downloaded.
Practice using the Bluebook app to familiarize yourself with the test format.

Jr. Retreat Parent Service hour opportunity!


