## What We Do

The Infants and Toddlers Program is an interagency initiative that supports eligible children birth to three and their families. Our focus is on achieving positive Early Childhood Outcomes:

- **Building Positive Social Relationships:**  
Encouraging interactions with peers and caregivers.
- **Acquiring and Using Knowledge and Skills:**  
Helping children engage effectively in activities.
- **Using Appropriate Behaviors:** Supporting children in expressing their needs and fostering independence.





Children may qualify if they are under three years old and meet one of the following:

- **Developmental Delay:** 25% delay in one or more developmental areas.
- **Diagnosed Condition:** A condition likely to result in developmental delays.
- **Atypical Development:** Displaying development that may lead to delays.

## What Happens After a Referral?

- **Contact by Service Coordinator:** A coordinator will reach out to schedule an evaluation at your home.
- **Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP):** If eligible, An IFSP will be developed within 45 days to guide the support and services your family will receive.



## Available Services

A primary provider will be designated based on your family's needs, collaborating with the team to offer tailored strategies. Early intervention services include:

- Assistive Technology
- Deaf and Hard of Hearing Services
- Occupational Therapy
- Physical Therapy
- Special Instruction
- Speech/Language Therapy
- Vision Services

Additional services may be available based on specific needs. **Services are available at no cost to families.**



## What to Expect During a Visit

- **Coaching Collaboration:** Building caregiver confidence in supporting skill development.
- **Family Engagement:** Discussing strategies and family priorities.
- **Observation:** Observing play and daily interactions.
- **Practice Together:** Implementing new ideas during the visit.
- **Joint Planning:** Creating a plan for strategies to practice between visits.
