	Special Presentation: 2023-2024 Budget Amendment Mrs. Keith went over the proposed budget amendment which included the General Fund, Athletic Fund, Food Service Fund and the Building & Site Capital Projects Fund - Enhancement.  • General Fund Balance projection is roughly 15%. • Overall revenue is up by 3.3 million. • \$458 increase per pupil for State Aid, now \$9608 • Expenditures are up 2.6 million • 85% of expenditures is for payroll  Mrs. Keith discussed the other funds as well along with answering the board members' questions and addressing their concerns. A copy of her PowerPoint presentation is included in the minutes for this meeting.

Special Presentation: UFLI Background Knowledge Implementation/Training

Dr. John Tafelski provided the board with information about this training that will be on the agenda for approval at the next regular meeting. The University of Florida Literacy Institute who provides training to districts to meet the needs for some of the science of reading components referred to as foundational literacy skills. This will be a 2-day training for each teacher, day 1 is background knowledge that provides an overview of the research that shows why it's important to make sure kids have these skills. Day 2 is comprehensive implementation training of the program. Dr. Tafelski went into detail about the program and the benefits to staff and students, explaining the cost that would come out of 31a funds. This training would be open to surrounding districts who would reimburse the district for part of the cost of the program. Dr. Tafelski answered the board members' questions and addressed any concerns.
