THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY

The International School of Luxembourg (ISL) is an independent, non-profit, university-preparatory day school situated in the city of Luxembourg, capital of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg. ISL offers a highquality English taught academic programme for children of both international and local families living in Luxembourg and the Greater Region. The school is divided into two sections of similar size: the Lower School, and the Upper School, the latter comprising Middle School and High School. Total school enrolment is approximately 1,350 students with over 450 students in the High School (grade 9-12). The ISL student body represents more than 60 nationalities, with over 70% of students coming from extended Europe. The highest represented nationalities are of the following countries: Italy (9.8%), France (9.8%), the USA (9.3%), Luxembourg (9.2%) and the UK (7.6%).

ACCREDITATION AND MEMBERSHIPS

ISL is accredited by the Council of International Schools and by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools. Memberships are held in the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO), the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS), and the International Association for College Admissions Counseling (IACAC).

SCHOOL CALENDAR

The academic year runs from late August to late June and is divided into three grading periods.

Term grades become available to students in **November, March** and **June**.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS AND DIPLOMAS AWARDED

ISL offers a standards-based university preparatory curriculum beginning with IGCSE in Grades 9 and 10. In Grades 11 and 12, this leads to the ISL High School Diploma and the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma or IB Course Certificates, or the ISL High School Diploma alone.



International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme

The International Baccalaureate (IB) mission is to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world. The IB Diploma Programme is a rigorous twoyear academic programme offered in Grades 11 and 12. This internationally recognised university entrance qualification requires the successful completion of six subjects, an Extended Essay, a Theory of Knowledge course, and a Creativity, Activity, Service component.

IB Course Certificates

Students who do not opt for the full IB Diploma may elect to sit IB examinations for selected subjects, and if successful, be awarded IB Course Certificates.

ISL High School Diploma

To be awarded the ISL High School Diploma, students must earn a minimum of 22 credits over the course of four academic years (through Grades 9 to 12) with the following subjects-specific workload:

English (4 credits), Mathematics, Sciences, Social Studies, Modern Languages (3 credits in each), other subjects (6 credits); and the completion of the Service Learning Programme.

Students can earn academic credit by achieving a grade of 3 to 7 in a full year's course at ISL (=1 credit), or through approved Learning Proposals within the ISL Initiatives Programme, including internships, mentorships, group or individual projects, and online classes.

ISL GRADING SYSTEM

The ISL grading system complies with the assessment scheme of the criterion-referenced International Baccalaureate (IB). Student performance is measured against specific learning outcomes. IB assessments are scored from 7 (excellent) to 1 (very poor). Students enroll in courses for the full school year and academic achievement is evaluated on a trimester basis in November, March and June. No academic credit is awarded for grades 1 or 2. Grades are not weighted.

Class rank and **grade point average (GPA)** are not computed due to the transient nature of the student body and the diversity of educational backgrounds of students enrolling during the high school years.


