- ➤ Parent Teacher Conferences: We will host Parent teacher conferences Friday,
 November 1, 2024. Please complete the Google form linked here 24-25 Parent
 Conference Request Form for Hutto High School to sign up to meet with your child's teacher(s). The form will close Friday, October 25, 2024 and as many conferences as possible will be scheduled. HHS personnel will get back with you to set up a conference time. Whether you plan to attend virtually or in person, please have your student present. We need to hear their voice, they need to see the partnership between their teacher(s) and their parents and that we are here to support them. Also, you do not have to wait to meet with the teachers until November 1, 2024. Parent teacher conferences are to occur, preferably proactively, as needed all year long. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to reach out to your child's teacher(s).
- ➤ PSAT 10th & 11th Graders: If your child is a 10th or 11th grader, they will take the PSAT (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test) Wednesday, October 16, 2024. This test will be administered during the school day. This testing administration will be treated with the same level of seriousness as we do our End of Course (EOC) exams. Students will be expected to follow directions and we ask that parents do not bring lunch to campus. A few things to ensure your child is prepared for that day:
 - Arrive to school on time!!!
 - o Bring their Chromebook to school and fully charged.
 - Bring their Chromebook charger with them.
 - If they have a loaner Chromebook, have them go to the library for additional information.
 - Be sure they get a good night's rest and breakfast that morning.
 - Encourage your child to do their very best!
- > **PSAT 12th Graders :** If your child is a 12th grader, they will participate in graduation requirements rotations and a fentanyl prevention session.
 - Rotation information here!
 - Report to school at 9am even if they have an off period.
 - Attendance will be taken during each rotation.

- ➤ Fire Alarms: Due to ongoing construction, fire alarms may be triggered more frequently.
