Friday, December 13, 2024 3:00 p.m. PST	Applications MUST be received by 3:00 pm PST on Friday, December 13, 2024 to be included in the lottery for Arts & Communication Magnet Academy (ACMA), International School of Beaverton (ISB), Beaverton Academy of Science and Engineering (BASE) and Rachel Carson Environmental Science Program (RLC).
Wednesday, December 18, 2024	Lottery conducted for programs where the number of applicants exceeds space available. Lottery is not public.
Friday, December 20, 2024	Letters offering enrollment or notification of wait-pool status will be sent via the email address listed on the application. Result cannot be given over the phone.
Friday, December 20, 2024 to Wednesday, January 8, 2025	Second Consideration: Students who are not selected in the first round of the lottery will receive an email indicating their wait-pool status and the opportunity to participate in Second Consideration – if available. Students who want to be considered for Second Consideration must notify their applicant school well before the Wednesday, January 8, 2025 deadline.
Friday, January 17, 2025 12:00 p.m. PST	Deadline for acceptance of enrollment offer. Families have the option to accept by: (1) using the Online Response Form , (2) emailing options@beaverton.k12.or.us , or (3) hand-delivered to the Beaverton School District Learning Options Office by 12:00 p.m. PST Friday, January 17, 2025.
Any openings remaining as a result of students declining enrollment offers and/or after the Second Consideration process will be filled from the wait pool. Students can still request enrollment following the first round of placement, though openings may be extremely limited.
