LEE COUNTY STUDENTS CONTINUE TO SURPASS STATE & NATIONAL SAT MEAN SCORE

Leesburg, GA -- Lee County School System students, during the 2023-2024 school year, outperformed both their state and national counterparts on the Scholastic Aptitude Test, one of the nation's standardized tests used for college admissions. The mean Scholastic Aptitude Test score for Lee County High School students also increased by five points from the previous year. This gain was accomplished while both the state and national student averages decreased.

About the latest student performance metrics, Dr. Karen Hancock, Lee County High School Principal, said, "Our students have consistently excelled with their SAT scores, demonstrating strong academic dedication. This is proven repeatedly by the numerous prestigious colleges and universities they enroll in after graduation, reflecting their hard work and bright futures".
