Federal Impact Forms/Federal Funds to BCSD – Also sent in an email earlier today

There are students across the county who have a family member working for the federal government or on federal property. We also have students receiving Special Education services through the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. Because BCSD educates these students, the school district can receive federal funds from the US Government. Please read below the guidelines to see if your family status would entitle Beaufort County School District to Federal Impact funds. If your family qualifies, please complete the attached survey and return it to HHIHS. Thanks.

What is it?

Federal funding that supports local school districts with concentrations of children who...

- Reside on Indian lands, military bases, low-rent housing properties, and other Federal properties
- Have parents in the uniformed services or employed on eligible Federal properties

Amount is based on an annual count of federally connected school children. Existed since 1950, is now known as Title VIII of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965.

Why is it provided?

Designed to assist local school districts that have lost property tax revenue due to the presence of tax-exempt Federal property, or that have experienced increased expenditures due to the enrollment of federally connected children.

Who is eligible? Children who...

- -Live on Indian Lands
- -Live on federal property (i.e., Laurel Bay, MCAS Beaufort, MCRD Parris Island, Naval Hospital Beaufort)
- -Live in federally subsidized low-rent housing
- -Parents are members of the uniformed services
- -Parents work on federal property (anywhere on the continental United States as federal or contracted employees)
- -Are eligible under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)

How can school districts use Impact Aid? For basic support such as...

- -Salaries for Teachers & Aides
- -Textbook purchases
- -Computers and other equipment
- -After school programs, remedial tutoring, advanced placement, special enrichment programs
- -Children with Disabilities Payments are dedicated funds
