Grade 9

Grade 10

NCAA Requirements

Grade 11

- Check with your counselor to make sure you will graduate on time with the required number of <u>NCAA core courses</u>.
- Take the <u>ACT or SAT</u> and submit your scores to the NCAA using code 9999.
- At the end of the year, ask your counselor to upload your <u>official transcript</u> to the NCAA Eligibility Center.

Grade 12

- Finish your last <u>NCAA core courses</u>.
- Take the <u>ACT or SAT</u> again, if necessary, and submit your scores to the NCAA using code 9999.
- Complete all academic and <u>amateurism</u> questions in your NCAA Eligibility Center account at <u>eligibilitycenter.org</u>.
- After you graduate, ask your counselor to submit your final <u>official</u> <u>transcript</u> with proof of graduation to the NCAA Eligibility Center.
