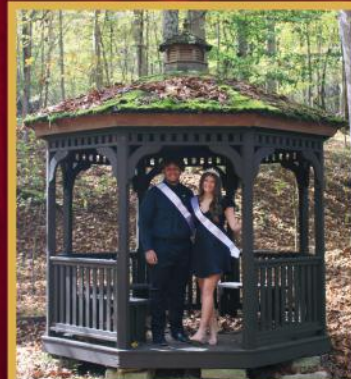
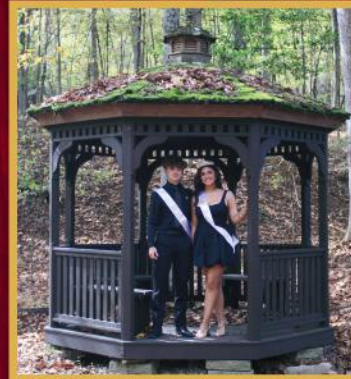

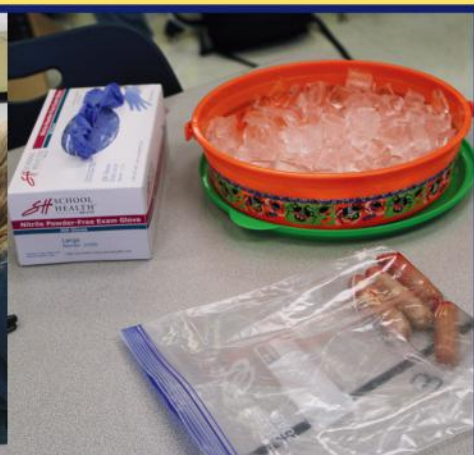

Students Learn "Hand"-y Lesson

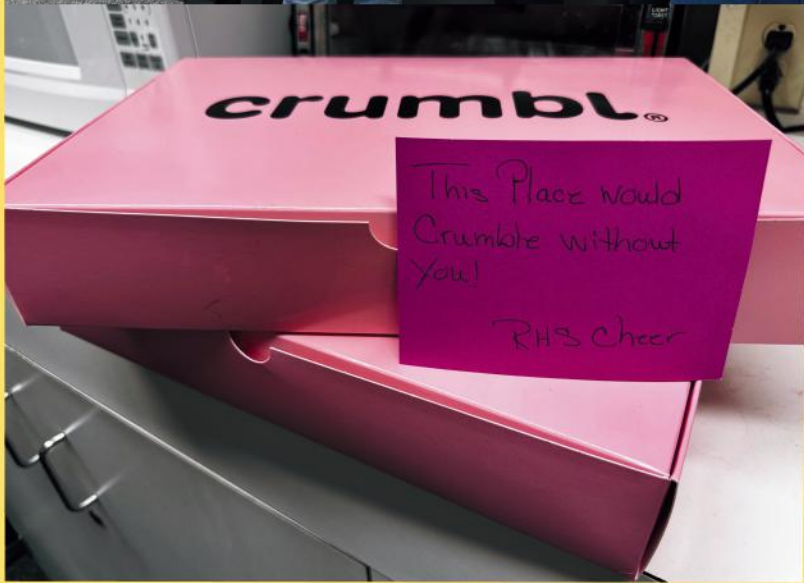
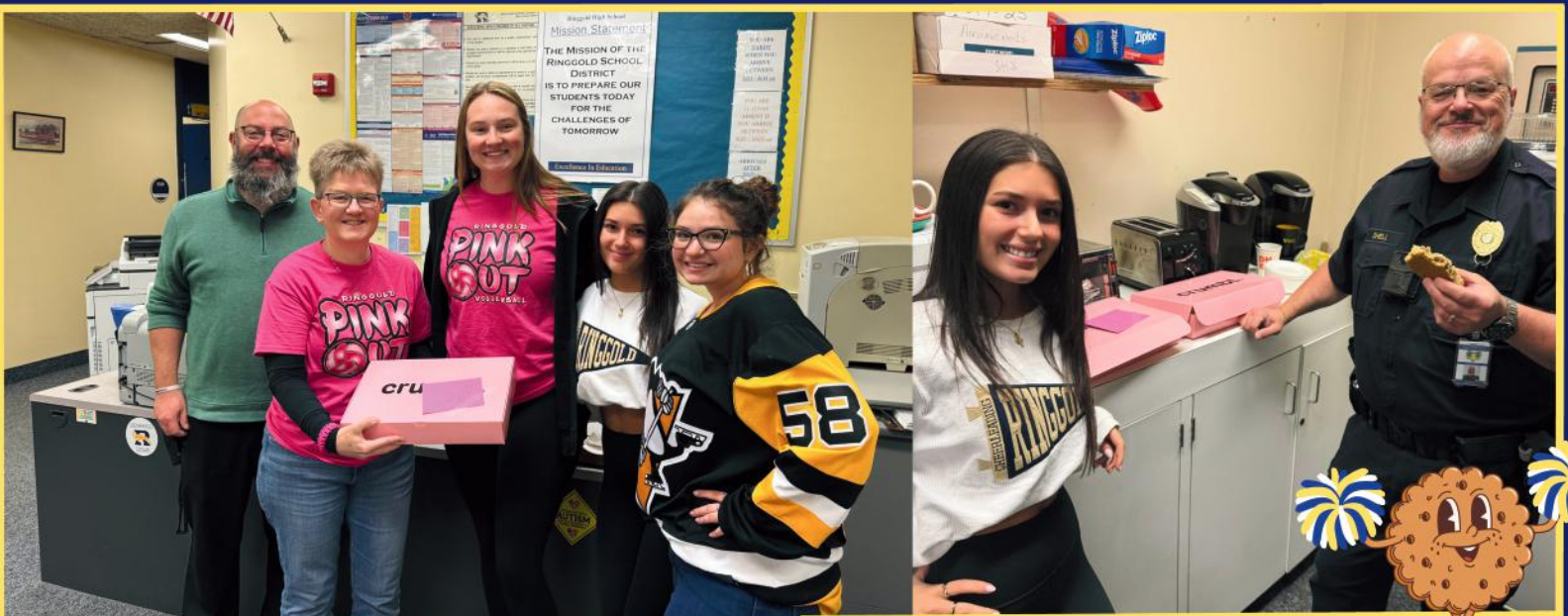

Teachers Were the Best...By Par!

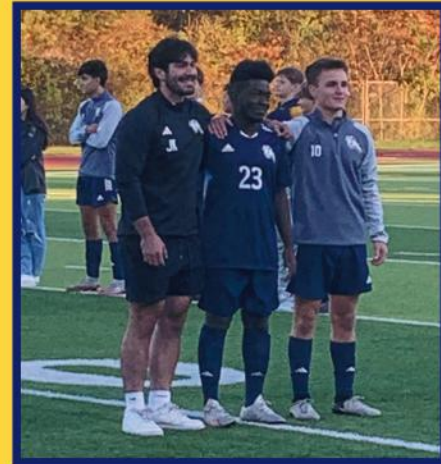

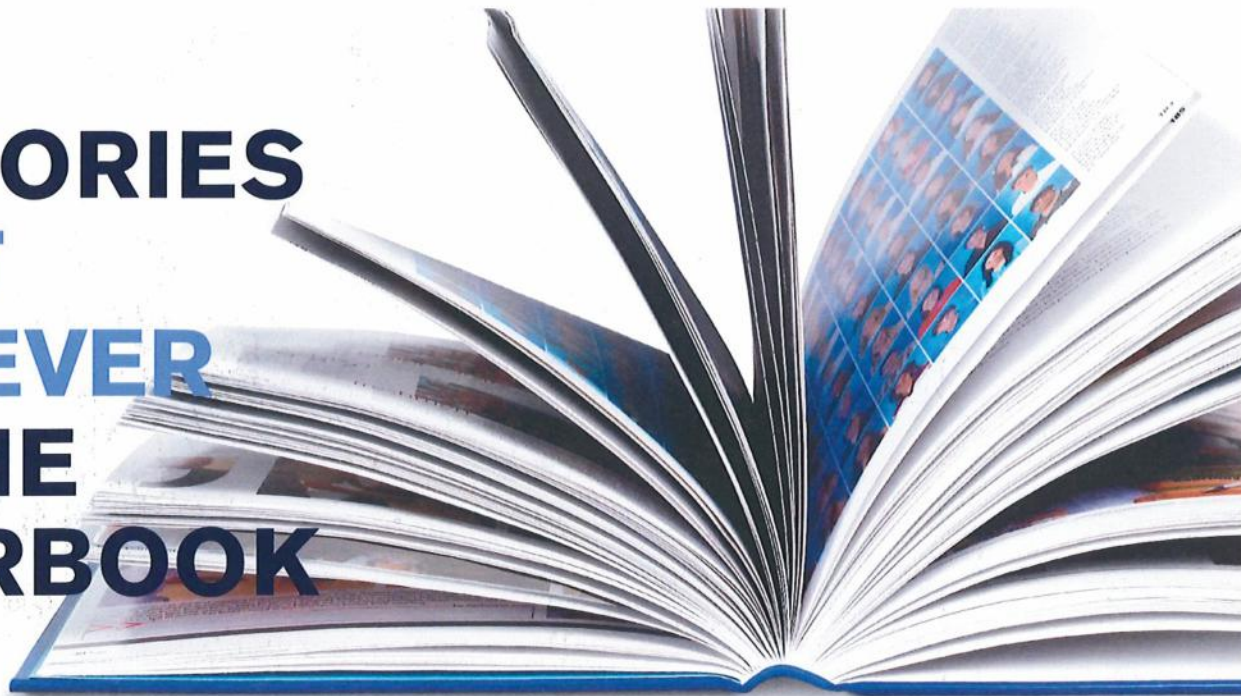
