PSYCHO-EDUCATIONAL EVALUATIONS

Collecting information through tests and other assessment tools to determine if students are eligible for special education services

INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PLANS (IEPs)

Collaborates with special education teachers to develop IEPs and monitor student progress

COMMUNICATION

Facilitating discussions between parents and educators to ensure the child's needs are understood and met

PROGRAM PLANNING

Consulting with other staff members to plan programs that meet students' special educational needs

FAMILY-SCHOOL PARTNERSHIPS

Helping families understand their children's learning and mental health needs, and connecting them with community service providers when necessary

STAFF UNDERSTANDING

Enhancing staff understanding of and responsiveness to diverse cultures and backgrounds
