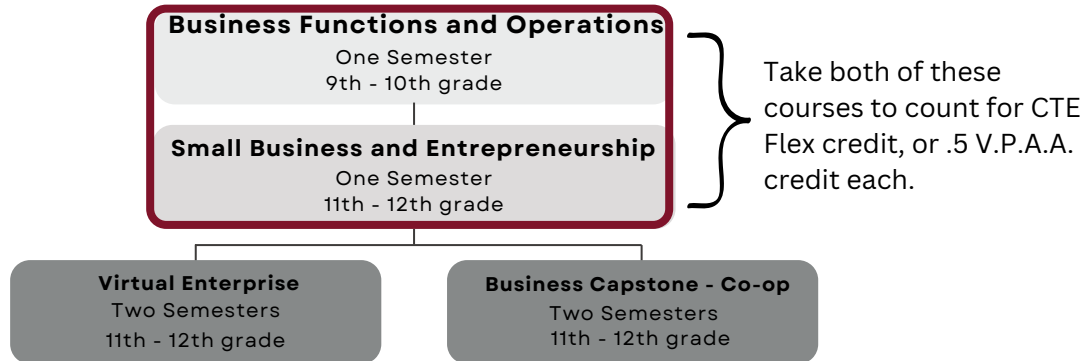



Business Administration, Management, Operations Program of Study
