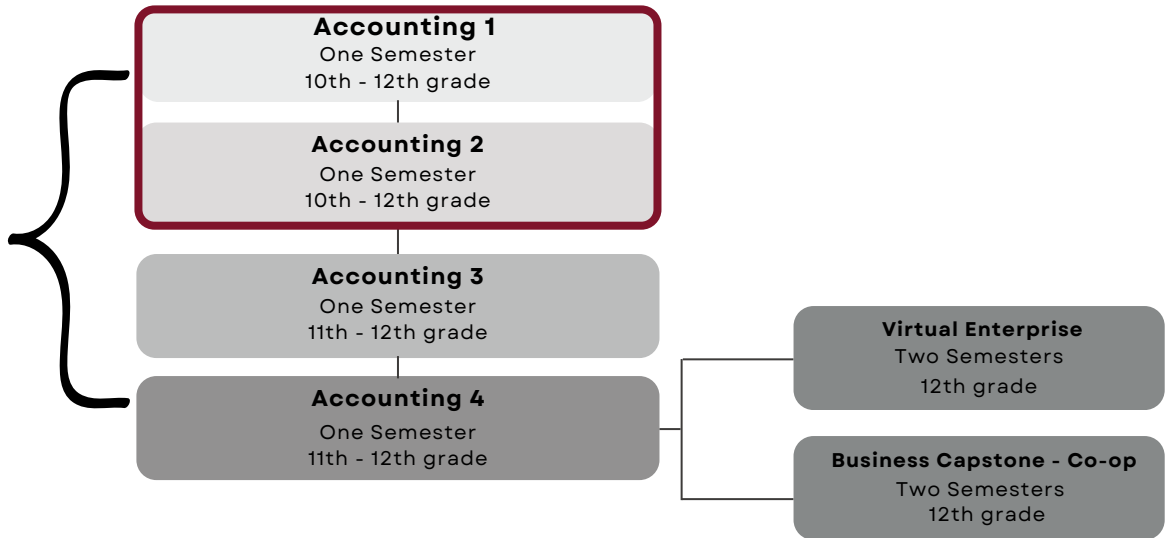



## Finance Program of Study
