WHY BE A PART OF SEAC?

The Committee includes parents of children with disabilities as well as persons involved or concerned with the education of children with disabilities. We offer activities for families as well as information to help parents navigate the system. We also support the Special Education Department in their endeavor to provide quality education to our children.

WHAT IS SEAC?

Under Virginia's Education Act, every student is entitled to an education that meets the student's needs. The Special Education Advisory Committee identifies, at a systems level, needs in the education of students with disabilities and develops advice and recommendations about how the school division can meet those needs. Local SEACs inform, counsel, recommend suggest or guide, and provide advice based on sound judgments developed from accurate information and facts. SEAC also provides Campbell County residents with an awareness of special education programs and services.

WHO MAY ATTEND SEAC?

All meetings are open to the public. Anyone interested in special education is welcome to attend the meetings. There is a designated time for public comment during the meeting. This is an opportunity to share successful educational experiences and express general concerns regarding issues for students with disabilities.
