Turn In: To turn in your homework, everyone will need to upload a picture of their work to the corresponding Schoology assignment.

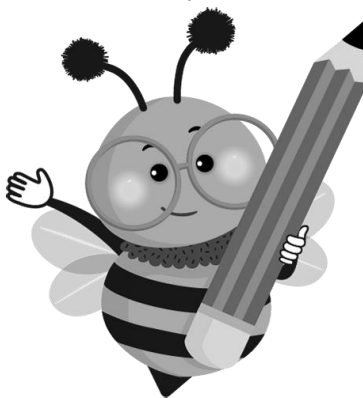
