

## STUDENT SOCIAL EVENTS

The Indian River School District recognizes that social events provide students with opportunities for social growth through student involvement in the planning and conduct of the events, as well as through the opportunity for student interaction. Therefore, school-sponsored groups, clubs, etc., may hold social events under staff authorization and supervision, provided that such events do not infringe on the instructional program and that costs of these events are kept to a reasonable level.

There shall be periodic evaluation of the social events in terms of contributions to student growth and morale.

Adequate chaperoning is to be provided at all events. In addition, when necessary, adequate police protection is to be provided.
