The Harrison Central School District is making a safety app available for parents to receive safety alerts from your child's school. The CrisisGo safety app will be used to inform you of school safety issues and to provide reliable, timely updates in the event of an emergency. The CrisisGo app is free to download by following the steps outlined in [this link](#). In addition, please encourage your children to download the Safe2SpeakUp app from the Apple Store or Google Play. They can sign in using Single Sign On (SSO) using their Google credentials. This will allow your child to receive alerts during a drill or real emergency along with important directions for safety in the event of a real emergency.

We are excited to announce that the Winter High School Sports registration (*Boys and Girls Basketball, Wrestling, Boys and Girls Bowling, Boys and Girls Indoor Track, Boys Swimming, Ice Hockey and Cheer*) will open on Friday, October 18th at 8am and will close on Monday, November 18th at 8am.

Registration for Winter LMK Modified School Sports for 7th and 8th Graders (*Cheer, Wrestling, Ice Hockey, Boys and Girls Basketball, Boys and Girls Indoor Track*) will open Friday, November 1st at 8am and will close on Monday Dec 2nd at 8am.

All registration must be done through our online platform [FamilyID](#). Late registration will not be accepted.

Winter LMK Modified Sport Start Date: 12/2/2024.

Please note that NYSPHSAA requires a physical exam dated within one calendar year of the sports start date. For high school sports the physical exam must be dated after 11/1/2023 . For Modified sports the physical exam must be dated after 12/1/2023.

The APP (Athletic Placement Process) is a program that allows physically and emotionally appropriate students to try out for an athletic team that is outside of their grade placement. This evaluation is a comprehensive evaluation of your child's emotional and physical maturity, athletic ability, physical fitness and sport specific athletic skill in relation to other student athletes at that level. The APP is not to be used to fill positions, instead it identifies the few select students who can benefit from such placement because of their level of readiness.

The [APP Packet](#), along with a coach's recommendation must be completed and handed into the LMK School Nurse by Wednesday, October 30th, 2024. The mandated Physical Fitness Test will be administered on November 6th, 2024 2:45pm LMK Gym B (Make-up day, November 7th, 2024- 2:45pm LMK Gym B). No late entries will be accepted.
