

**RESOLUTION
ELMSFORD UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT
COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK
REGARDING THE SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING
FOR BUDGET REVOTE**

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Section 1: A Budget Hearing of the Elmsford Union Free School District, County of Westchester, New York, shall be held in the Alexander Hamilton Jr/Sr High School Auditorium, 98 South Goodwin Avenue, Elmsford, New York, in said School District, on June 12, 2023 at 7:00 p.m.

Section 2: A Special School District Meeting of the qualified voters of Elmsford Union Free School District, in the County of Westchester, New York, shall be held in the Alice E. Grady Music Room, Cobb Lane, Elmsford, NY, in said District, on June 20, 2023 at 7:00 a.m. for the purpose of a revote upon a revised 2023-2024 Annual Budget. The voting at such Special School District Meeting shall be by ballot on voting machines as provided by the Education Law and the polls shall remain open from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on said day.

Section 3: The business to be acted upon at said Special School District Meeting For Budget Re-vote and Budget Hearing shall be as stated in the Notice thereof, and the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Notice of said Budget Hearing and Special School District Meeting For Budget Re-vote to be published in *The Journal News*, the official newspaper of said District, said publication to be made two times within the two weeks preceding the Special School District Meeting For Budget Re-vote, the first such notice to be published no later than June 6, 2023 and the second and final notice to be published no later than June 13, 2023.

Notice is hereby given that the Special Budget Hearing of the qualified voters of Elmsford Union Free School District, in the County of Westchester, New York, shall be held in the Alexander Hamilton Jr/Sr High School Auditorium, 98 South Goodwin Avenue, Elmsford, New York, in said District on June 12, 2023 at 7:00 PM.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Special School District Meeting for Budget Revote of the qualified voters of Elmsford Union Free School District, in the County of Westchester, New York, will be held on Tuesday, June 20, 2023 in the Alice E. Grady Elementary School Music Room, Cobb Lane, Elmsford, New York from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. for the purpose of voting upon:

1. The Revised 2023/2024 Elmsford School District Budget as adopted by the Board of Education.

Voting will be by ballot on voting machines as provided by the Education Law and the polls will remain open from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and as much longer as may be necessary to enable the voters then present to cast their ballots in the Music Room at the Alice E. Grady School.

In accordance with the provision of Section 1716 of the Education Law, the Board of Education of the Elmsford Union Free School District has prepared a revised detailed statement of the amount of money which will be required for the ensuing year for school purposes exclusive of the public moneys, specifying the several purposes and the amount of each.

A copy of this statement may be obtained by any resident in the district, at the Office of the Board of Education, Alexander Hamilton High School, 98 South Goodwin Avenue, Elmsford, New York; or each of the public schools in the district, beginning on June 6, 2023 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on each day other than Saturday or Sunday or other school district holidays. Annexed to this statement will be an Exemption Report showing how much of the total assessed value on the final assessment roll(s) used in the budgetary process is exempt from taxation.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF THE DISTRICT SHALL MEET ON: Monday, June 12, 2023 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Alexander Hamilton Jr/Sr High School, 98 South Goodwin Avenue, Elmsford, NY, Tuesday, June 13, 2023 from 12:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Alice E. Grady Elementary School, Cobb Lane, Elmsford, NY, and the Carl L. Dixson Primary School at 22 South Hillside Avenue, Elmsford, NY for the purpose of preparing a Register of the qualified voters of the District for said Special School

District Meeting at which time any person shall be entitled to have his/her name placed upon such Register provided that at such meeting of the Board of Registration he/she is known or proven to the satisfaction of such Board of Registration to be then or thereafter entitled to vote at the next Annual Meeting and Election held after which such Register is prepared.

Military voters who are not currently registered may apply to register as a qualified voter of the school district. Military voters may apply to register to vote with the District Clerk in person at the District Office, 98 South Goodwin Avenue, Elmsford, NY, or by calling that office 914-592-6632. Upon such request for a military voter application, such military voter may indicate his/her preference for receiving the application for registration by mail, facsimile or electronic mail. Such registration application must be received in the office of the District Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 5, 2023. Any military voter shall be entitled to have his/her name placed upon such register, provided, that he/she is known or proven to be to the satisfaction of the District Clerk, to be then or thereafter entitled to military voter status at the annual meeting and election for which such register is prepared.

Military voters who received a ballot for the May 16, 2023 Meeting and Election will automatically be issued a military ballot for the June 20, 2023 Special Meeting by the same method by which the military voter received his/her military ballot for the May 16, 2023 Meeting and Election.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Board of Registration and Canvas of this District will meet during the Special School District Meeting at the time and place when such annual election is held for the purpose of preparing a register for meetings and elections held more than thirty (30) days subsequent to such Special School District Meeting.

A copy of said Registers will be available for public inspection by qualified voters in the office of the District Clerk immediately upon its completion, but in no event later than June 15, 2023. Said Registers will be available for inspection during each of the five (5) days preceding the Special School District Meeting between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm, except Sunday, and by appointment only with the District Clerk between the hours of 9:00 am and 12:00 pm Saturday, June 17, 2023. A copy of said final Registers will also be available for public inspection from the opening to the closing of the polls at the polling place at the Alice E. Grady Elementary School on the day of the Special School District Meeting.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that applications for absentee ballots may be obtained at the Office of the School District Clerk. Applications for absentee ballots must be received by the School District Clerk by or prior to 4:00 p.m., Prevailing Time, on June 13, 2023, if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter or, if the ballot is to be picked up by the voter or his/her designated agent, during the hours of 10-2 p.m., Prevailing Time, on June 19, 2023. Upon receiving a timely application for a mailed absentee ballot, the District Clerk will mail the ballot to the address designated on the application by no later than six (6) days before the Special School District Meeting.

Absentee ballots must be received by the School District Clerk not later than 5:00 p.m., Prevailing Time, on June 20, 2023. A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots shall have been issued will be available in the office of the School District Clerk on each of the five days preceding the Special School District Meeting, between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm, except Sunday, and by appointment only with the District Clerk between the hours of 9:00 am and 12:00 pm Saturday, June 17, 2023 and such list shall also be posted at the voting place during the Special School District Meeting, and any qualified voter may challenge the acceptance of the absentee voter's

ballot of any person on such list, by making his challenge and the reasons therefore known to the Inspector of Election before the close of the polls.

In accordance with Part 122 of the Rules and Regulations of the Commissioner of Education, military voters who are qualified voters of the school district may apply for a military ballot. Applications for military ballots may be requested from the District Clerk or by calling that office 914-592.6632. Upon such request for a military voter ballot application, such military voter may indicate his/her preference for receiving the application by mail, facsimile or electronic mail. Completed military ballot applications must be received by the Clerk of the District no later than 5:00 pm on June 5, 2023.

A list of all persons to whom military ballots shall have been issued will be available in the office of the School District Clerk on each of the five days preceding the Special School District Meeting between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm, except Sunday, and by appointment only with the District Clerk between the hours of 9:00 am and 12:00 pm Saturday, June 17, 2023 and such list shall also be posted at the voting place during the Special School District Meeting.
