A public hearing was opened for comments and questions regarding he District 205 Fiscal Year 2025 Budget. No one from the public was in attendance. Every board member engaged in a discussion and asked questions regarding the increase in EBF revenue, \$28M in tax rebates in the past five years back to residents, etc. Mr. Horton answered all questions. Mr. Dauksas provided more information regarding individual property tax assessment and the south suburbs property tax increase. This is due to Cook County's increased assessment of our local areas and not our School Board of Education. Once all questions were answered, the public hearing was closed. Dr. Davis moved, Mrs. Moody seconded the Approval of District Fiscal Year 2025 Budget. On roll call, Members Davis, Moody, Banks, and Graham voted aye; voted nay, none; motion passed.

Mr. Horton presented the Fiscal Year 2025 Procurement Plan. The goal of a procurement plan is to increase the efficiency, effectiveness, and transparency of the procurement process.
