

The Board will accept comments via email statements to be read at the meeting. Public comments were emailed to hill.laura@district205.net.



TW 2021-22 EOY Advance Placement Test Results

- 2021-2022 saw massive increases in AP scores.
- Overall, we had 28% of students who scored a 3 or above, which is an 18% increase from last year. This is also our highest percentage of students who received this score in 5 years.
- AP Literature and AP Calculus had the highest pass rate among all AP courses.
- Each had 60% of students pass the exam.
 - Coincidentally, both courses also had 2 students score a 5 on the related exam. Kudos to Mr. Biesiada and Ms. Scaletta.

TW 2021-22 EOY International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme Percentages

- The Thornwood IB Program is thrilled to announce that is has led the District with the highest percentage of students who earned the IB Diploma this past year. We would like to highlight Ajayla Self, Estrella Gonzalez, and Hazeeza Olaniran as our top three performers who have led the way and achieved extraordinary marks.
- Furthermore, 24 of our IB students have earned college credit one or more course! These students demonstrated perseverance and resilience as they navigated Covid and remote learning during their time in the program. We are so proud of them.
- We are also pleased to report some highlights in our TW IB classes.
 - IB Spanish had all but one student pass and earn college credit, including 4 perfect scores.
 - IB Math Applications and Analysis had a pass rate of 75%
 - IB Visual Art had a pass rate of 66%
 - Our IB Higher Level courses (including History, Psychology, and English) all had near or more than 50% pass rate.
