All 11th grade students will be testing for **SAT's on April 10, 2018** at Outlook Academy in all classrooms.



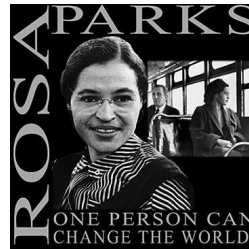
