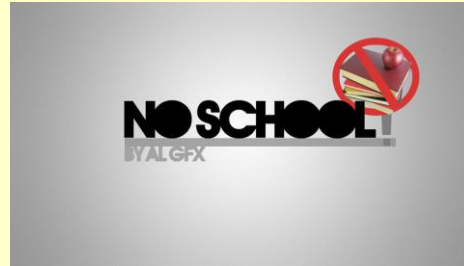
Reminders to Students
