Registration in PowerSchool

The start of school is fast approaching. Freshman students start <u>August 12th</u> and all students begin <u>August 13th</u>. If you haven't enrolled your student(s) yet, you might miss out on several benefits of timely registration, ensuring a smooth start to the school year. Here are some key advantages of registering your child as soon as possible:

- Waived Fees: All student registration fees are waived during the early enrollment period.
- Smooth Start: A timely registration ensures students can begin school on the first day of the new term without any delays.

PowerSchool simplifies access to students' information with a single sign-on option. This feature allows parents to create one account to access information for each child in the family.

Once you have your child's Access ID and Password, you are ready to set up a PowerSchool account.

FOR NEW STUDENTS

Parents of new students received a separate Access ID and Password for each student they will enroll.

FOR RETURNING STUDENTS

Parents of returning students will use the Access IDs and Passwords from the previous year.

If you have forgotten your student's password, a password reset is available in PowerSchool. However, if you have forgotten the Access ID, please contact the school office.

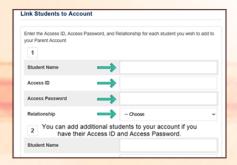

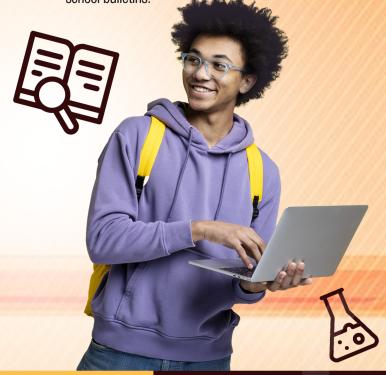

Returning students can use their previous year's credentials. If you've forgotten your Access ID or Password, contact the school office or email register@district205.net.

Medical Clearance for the 2024-2025 School Year

Medical clearance is a required step in School District 205's student registration process. This requirement helps ensure a safe environment for both students and staff and confirms that students are healthy enough to attend classes and participate in school activities.

What do parents need for Medical Clearance?

Parents must provide the following documents to their child's school for medical clearance:

- Incoming freshman or transfer students:
 - 1. Current physical exam report
- 2. Up-to-date immunization records
- 3. Current dental exam report
- 4. Emergency contact information
- 5. Authorization for the administration of medication, if applicable
- Senior students:
 - 1. Proof of the meningitis vaccine

Please ensure all documents are submitted to facilitate a smooth registration process.

COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement

Currently, students are not required to be vaccinated for COVID-19 to register for school.

Deadline for Medical Clearance

Parents are encouraged to complete school enrollment in PowerSchool and provide the necessary medical clearance documents no later than **October 15**, **2024**. The link to PowerSchool is available on the District 205 website (www.district205.net).
