# Confidentiality and Public Information

- Generally, security documents, records, and information reviewed by the committee or discussion of the documents and records should **remain confidential**.
- Texas Education Code section 37.2071(i) makes any document or information collected, developed, or produced during the review and verification of a multi-hazard EOP not subject to disclosure under the Texas Public Information Act (PIA).
- Texas Education Code section 37.108(c-1) provides that any document or information collected, developed, or produced during a safety and security audit conducted under the provision requiring regular safety and security audits of a district's facilities is confidential and not subject to disclosure under the Texas Public Information Act (PIA).
- Access to documents and records by committee members are to be confidentiality protected and not shared with the public. **Any security documents, records, or information shall only be released by the District with permission from the Texas Attorney General.**

# Purpose

- The purpose of the Safety and Security Committee is to assist with the development and implementation of emergency planning recommendations consistent with the district multi-hazard emergency operations plan and to ensure accurate reporting of information requested by the Texas School Safety Center.

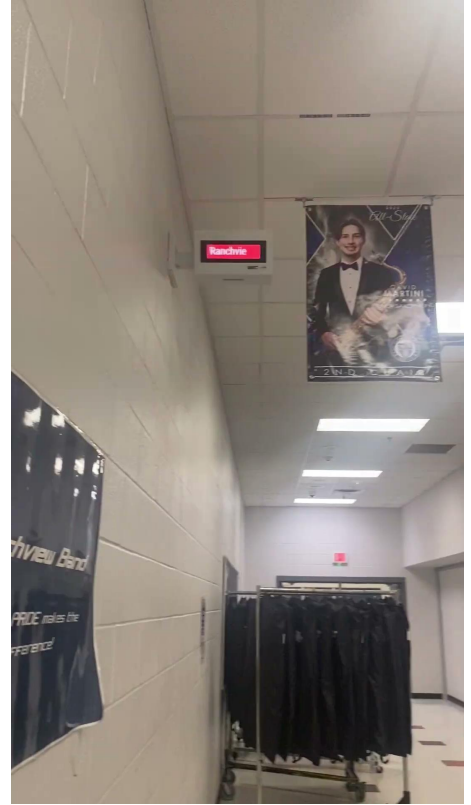
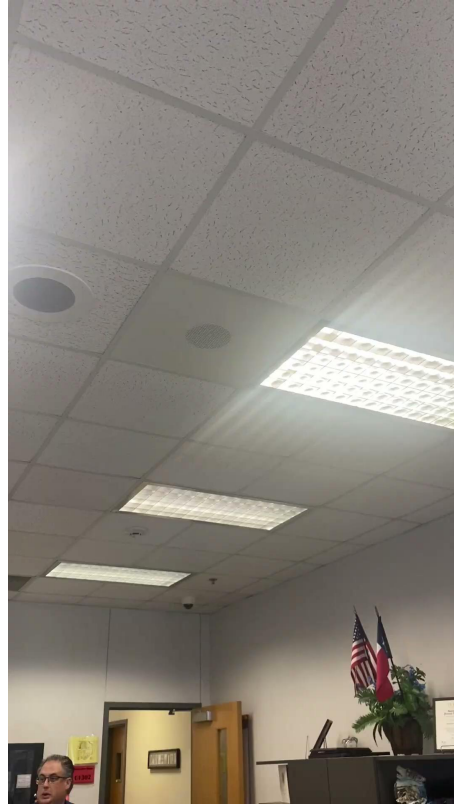

# Bond -PA System Update

- 2023 Bond Project
- Prior work completed PA headend equipment (microphones, speakers, alarm tones, etc.) installation and moved PA system to a new platform, but was not a complete system replacement. Finish-out will balance the system and finalize adequate coverage throughout buildings
- Safety & Security Department is partnering with Construction
- Ranchview HS completed in Summer of 2024
  - Smith/Creekview HS began in September of 2024
  - Turner HS will begin in October of 2024\*
  - Smith & Turner will be affected by major construction updates
- MS scope pushed out already to contractor, and will begin as soon as HS scope is completed
- ES scope will begin after MS (Rosemeade, Rainwater)

**Estimated 1.9 million to address just the HS PA scope**

# Formula Grant - Impact Film/Fencing

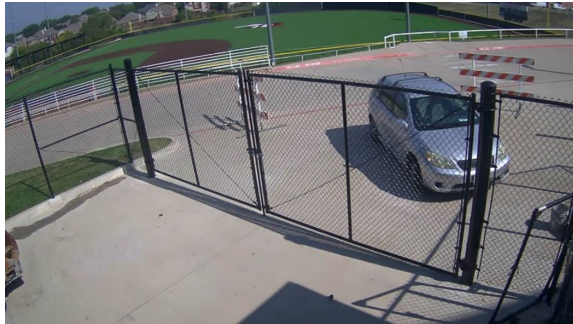
- Awarded 1.1 million
- Bid awarded to NGS (National Glaze Solutions) to address window film (550k)
- They will update all buildings to some extent
- Formula grant only covers instructional campuses
- Installing in non-instructional sites first (to verify work completed and check the standards)
  - Campuses will begin end of September of 2024\*

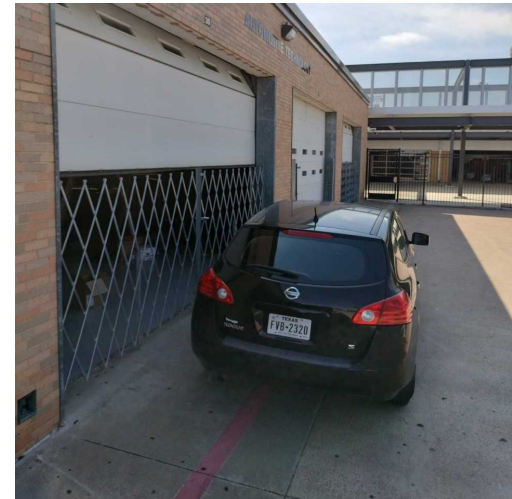
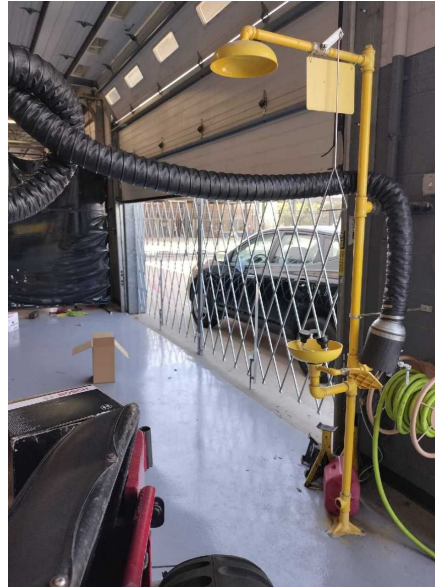

- Cinco Peso (ALERRT style training)
- Video camera equipment
- Radio repeater for a couple of campuses
- Cost for SRO's

# SPAT Grant - Raptor Emergency App (REM)

- Secondary Campuses that are REALLY close: Bush MS, Field MS, Perry MS, Ranchview HS (All in the 90's)

## Known Issues:

- Short term subs do not have access to REM
- Extra Staff (District employees) assigned to campus (MARK THEM ABSENT)
- App based so some staff refuse to download to personal devices
  - Offer incentives
  - Stress the positives
  - Set the tone (campus admin buy in)
  - multi - building profiles tend to get a lot of alerts

# Safe Cycle 2 Grant

- Awarded a total of \$860,551
- Raptor Emergency Management & Visitor/Volunteer Software
  
- Raptor - 2nd printer/scanner for every campus
- Radio Inventory for every campus
- Cinco Peso training for Security staff

## Drill Expectations & Changes

- 1 evacuation per month (10+ school days)
- 1st Semester - Secure, Shelter, Lockdown (**complete within first 10 days of school**)
- 2nd Semester - Secure, Shelter-HazMat, Lockdown (**complete by Spring Break**)
- SB 11/Local Fire Code/Tx SSC/TEA

**Must be run through Raptor to count**



## Sentinel of Safety

**The Sentinel of Safety Award will be presented to one campus who actively and consistently promotes a culture of school safety.**

- Projects should apply to the entire campus, and should affect more than a small group of students.
- Project must demonstrate the campus going above and beyond the minimum safety standards.

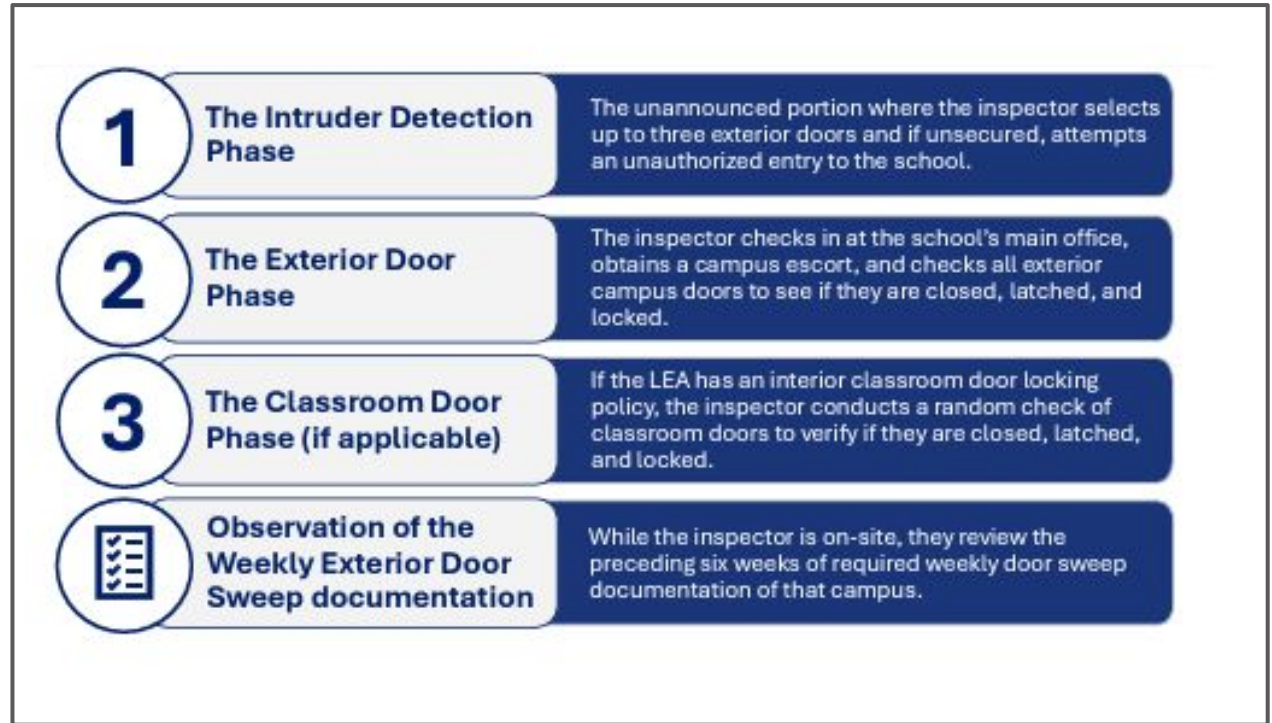

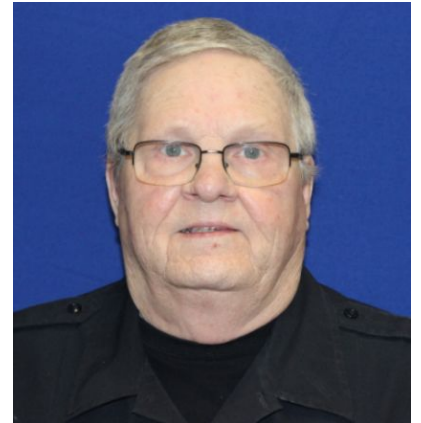

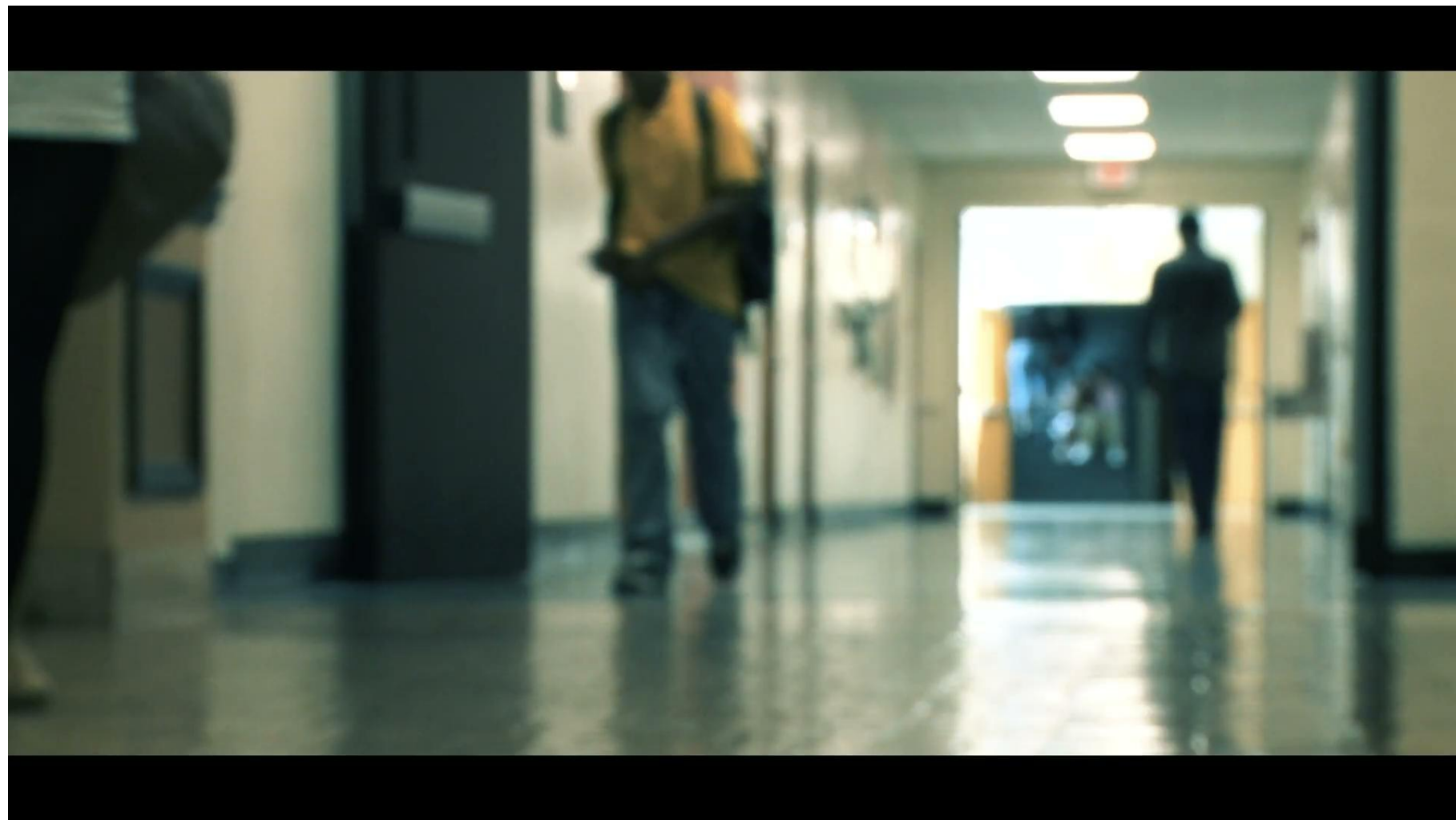
- Region 10 will ask for a couple of items when they arrive to complete your IDA

# District Campus Checks

- Rodney Courson, will begin auditing all campuses for exterior door compliance. He will be dressed in plain clothes. He will not have a utility belt, firearm, or vest on his person. He will have his CFBISD District badge on him, but it will not be prominently displayed. His primary focus will be on checking exterior doors, but will also audit Visitor procedures.
- Please remind all front office personnel to screen each visitor prior to allowing them access to our buildings. Please reach out to Adam Lewin or Rachael Freeman with any concerns or questions.
- The goal is that every campus will be checked by him every month.
- He will be emailing out reports detailing his findings.

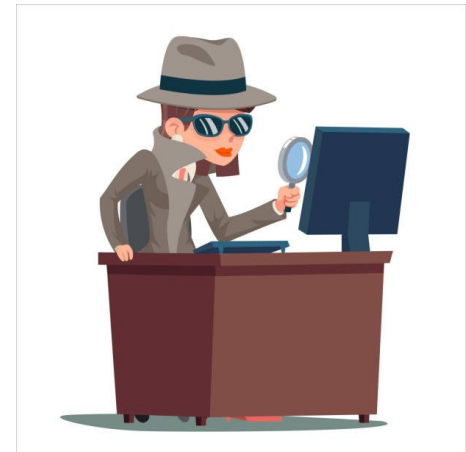




# Threat Investigations - How Do We Know?



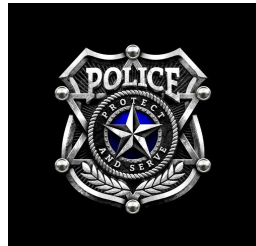
# Threat Investigations - What Happens Next? (Police)

# Threat Investigations - Offenses

Sec. 22.07. **TERRORISTIC THREAT.** (a) A person commits an offense if he threatens to commit any offense involving violence to any person or property with intent to:

- (1) cause a reaction of any type to his threat by an official or volunteer agency organized to deal with emergencies;
- (2) place any person in fear of imminent serious bodily injury;
- (3) prevent or interrupt the occupation or use of a building, room, place of assembly, place to which the public has access, place of employment or occupation, aircraft, automobile, or other form of conveyance, or other public place;
- (4) cause impairment or interruption of public communications, public transportation, public water, gas, or power supply or other public service;
- (5) place the public or a substantial group of the public in fear of serious bodily injury; or
- (6) influence the conduct or activities of a branch or agency of the federal government, the state, or a political subdivision of the state.

(b) An offense under Subsection (a) (1) is a Class B misdemeanor.

(c) An offense under Subsection (a) (2) is a Class B misdemeanor, except that the offense is a Class A misdemeanor if the offense:

- (1) is committed against a member of the person's family or household or otherwise constitutes family violence; or
- (2) is committed against a public servant.

(c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (c) (2), an offense under Subsection (a) (2) is a state jail felony if the offense is committed against a person the actor knows is a peace officer or judge.

(d) An offense under Subsection (a) (3) is a Class A misdemeanor, unless the actor causes pecuniary loss of \$1,500 or more to the owner of the building, room, place, or conveyance, in which event the offense is a state jail felony.

(e) An offense under Subsection (a) (4), (a) (5), or (a) (6) is a felony of the third degree.

# Threat Investigations - Offenses

Sec. 42.06. FALSE ALARM OR REPORT. (a) A person commits an offense if he knowingly initiates, communicates or circulates a report of a present, past, or future bombing, fire, offense, or other emergency that he knows is false or baseless and that would ordinarily:

- (1) cause action by an official or volunteer agency organized to deal with emergencies;
- (2) place a person in fear of imminent serious bodily injury; or
- (3) prevent or interrupt the occupation of a building, room, place of assembly, place to which the public has access, or aircraft, automobile, or other mode of conveyance.

(b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor unless the false report is of an emergency involving a public or private institution of higher education or involving a public primary or secondary school, public communications, public transportation, public water, gas, or power supply or other public service, in which event the offense is a state jail felony.
