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### *Master of Education in Special Education with Certification as Educational Diagnostician*

UNT offers certification as an educational diagnostician through an online venue. The educational diagnostician certificate may be earned concurrently with a master's degree or as a certification-only option if the candidate already has a master's degree. The M.Ed. in Special Education consists of 33 hours, all of which are available online, but some Saturday seminars are required. Though you can begin coursework any semester, if you begin taking courses in the summer, the coursework can be

The online format gives the option of working on classes at a time that is convenient to varied personal schedules. Financial aid may be available through the Toulouse School of Graduate Studies for students who are working on a master's degree and meet qualification guidelines.

If you already have a master's degree, and opt for the educational diagnostician certification only, a deficiency plan will be written for you. Coursework must be current (within 5 years) and applicable for consideration of transfer. Assessment courses and educational statistics must be taken through UNT, as they are cornerstones of our program.
