- 9-19-24: Attended and Chaired the ECASB Legislative Team Meeting
 - An hour before the meeting we had a reception / meet and greet for the new members of the team
 - Review summer work by team
 - Reviewed some changes in the ECASB Takes A Stand Document
 - Legislative Breakfast 11-16-24, 8:30 – noon. Invite our PTA/PTSA/PTO reps
 - Rural Schools Conference December 4-5 in Saratoga
 - Capital Conference split. First portion virtual. Still in person for meetings
- 9-26-24: Attended ENL Graduation Ceremony
 - Nearly 50 students across most grade levels were recognized
- 10-2-24: Attended Audit Committee Meeting
 - Jeremy from Lumsden McCormick gave the committee a presentation about the recently completed external audit
 - Everything was in good order. Committee voted to approve and send to BOE
- 10-3-24: Attended Willow Ridge PTO Meeting
 - 20 people in attendance, intros of everyone there
 - Principal's Report: Several items including the Halloween Parade. Info going out shortly
 - I gave a brief report on current activities of the Board
 - Teacher report: The kids loved the Fun Run videos. There are many new teams being formed under the Leader in Me program
 - Treasurer reported they are in good financial condition

- 10-7-24: Attended Sweet Home Education Foundation Meeting (SHEF)
 - Meeting was held at Raymour & Flanigan. They will donate \$500, plus did a food drive
