Make the check out to "Fairview High School" in the amount of \$99 (or request a fee waiver) with "AP Chinese" and the student's name as registered with the College Board/AP in the memo line. AP Chinese exam registration is not on RevTrak. Please make sure that you are in touch with Nettie Welk at nettie.welk@bvsd.org about taking the exam. After dropping off the check, the student will then need to login to the College Board/AP system (or create an account) and enter the Join Code provided by Ms. Welk. The Join Code step is required in order to receive the exam. The last day Mr. Weber will accept \$ will be Thursday, October 31, 2024. AP Chinese Language and Culture will be on Friday, May 9, 2025. The exam will be administered at the BVSD Education Center at 6500 Arapahoe Avenue in Boulder. The exams are open to all BVSD students, (not just Fairview), so please spread the word. ### **Mental Health Moment**



What is anxiety?

Anxiety is a common feeling that so many people experience. It can be an emotion that almost all of us have dealt with, it can also be a frequent experience that impacts our life. You might feel a mix of nervousness, worry, and unease about something with an uncertain outcome. Situations like waiting to hear back about a job interview or preparing for a big test can trigger anxiety. Unfortunately, anxiety doesn't always have an identifiable trigger, and anxiety can linger and become a regular part of your life. It can affect your everyday activities and bring a wide range of symptoms along with it.

Symptoms of anxiety can include:

Aches and pains / Physical inactivity / Change in appetite / Inability to focus and concentrate / Irritability / Difficulty sleeping / Rapid heartbeat and breathing /

Sweating

Understanding the symptoms of anxiety can help you learn how to manage them. One effective way to do this is through breathing exercises specifically designed for calming anxiety.

Breath work can have a powerful effect on our nervous system. The nervous system is the complex network that controls everything we feel and do. Breathing exercises can impact our nervous system in the following ways:

Slowing your heart rate

Lowering your blood pressure

Increasing oxygen flow

According to <u>Calm</u>, when you practice deep breathing techniques regularly, your body starts to learn a new pattern. Over time, this can lead to a general feeling of calm and relaxation, making it easier to handle moments of anxiety when they arise. <u>These specific breathing</u> <u>techniques</u> from <u>www.Calm.com</u> are proven to help decrease the intensity of our anxiety experience.


