Dear Parent or Guardian:

In September 2000, Governor Davis signed into law the Healthy Schools Act of 2000. This law requires school districts to notify parents, guardians, and school employees about pesticides used in their schools. Every school district is to implement the following requirements:

- Parents and guardians of students will have access to all pesticide products the school district expects to use on the school grounds on the district website. These products include over-the-counter pesticides available at retail outlets.
- Each school will establish a list of parents or guardians who want to be notified before individual pesticide applications are made. Notices will be given 72 hours before.
- Each school district will ensure warning notices are posted in areas where pesticides will be applied. Posting will begin 24 hours before and 72 hours after an application and will include information required by law.
- Each district will maintain records of all pesticides used at the sites for 4 years. Upon request, these records will be available to the public.

It is our goal to limit as much as possible the amount of spraying that is occurring at our school sites. The Grounds and Custodial Departments will continue to employ mechanical practices and policies to reduce dependence on chemicals for pest and weed control. For your information, records of spray dates, types of compounds used, treated areas, and quantities used are available for public review at the Maintenance and Operations Office located at 321 North Thornburg, Santa Maria.

Estimados padres/tutores:

El septiembre del año 2000, el gobernador Davis firmó la ley del Acta de escuelas Saludables del 2000. Esta ley requiere que los distritos escolares notifiquen a los padres, tutores y empleados escolares sobre los pesticidas usados en sus escuelas. Cada distrito escolar deberá implementar los siguientes requisitos:

- Los padres y tutores de los estudiantes tendrán acceso a todos los productos pesticidas del distrito escolar en el sitio web del distrito escolar de todos los productos de pesticidas que se espera usar en la escuela. Estos productos incluyen pesticidas que se pueden comprar en cualquier tienda.
- Cada escuela establecerá una lista de padres o tutores que desean ser notificados antes de que se use cualquier pesticida. Notificaciones será 72 horas antes.
- Cada distrito escolar se asegurará de anunciar en las áreas donde se usarán los pesticidas. Los anuncios se pondrán 24 horas antes y 72 horas después de que se hayan usado los pesticidas e incluirán la información requerida por ley.
- Todos los distritos mantendrán, por 4 años, información archivada sobre el uso de todos los pesticidas en las escuelas. Bajo pedido estos archivos estarán disponibles para el público.

Es nuestra meta limitar lo más posible la cantidad del uso de pesticidas en nuestras escuelas. El departamento encargado de los terrenos y edificios continuará usando en la práctica y en sus pólizas reducir los químicos para control de insectos nocivos, y pasto malo. Para su información, se mantendrá récords de los días en que se tiró el pesticida, tipos de componente, áreas tratadas, y cantidad usada. Esta información estará disponible para el público en la oficina de mantenimiento ubicada al 321 North Thornburg en Santa Maria.
