2017-2018 Measure E Parcel Tax Financial Summary

Income -

The total amount collected by the County Tax Collector's Office for the year was \$2,110,440. The County Tax collector's Office charged \$1.35 per parcel levied for collection of fees totaling \$49,947. The district issued \$360 refunds of parcel taxes to homeowners in 2017/18. There was \$639,196 unspent 2016/17 balance. The net amount available for 2017/18 was \$2,699,329.

Expenditures -

Funds expended in 2017/18 totaled \$2,425,974. Those expenditures included funds to enhance math, science, reading and writing (\$75,798 for additional summer school program; \$420,314 for Librarians), to provide career training, college preparation/21st century computer instruction (\$20,743 to restore school athletic budgets; \$45,063 to restore school site and fine arts instructional budgets; \$221,845 to provide clerical support; \$1,571,753 for counseling time); and \$70,458 for outside professional service to administer the parcel tax. There was \$273,355 in unspent funds to be carried over to the 2018/19 school year. The following charts illustrate the 2017/18 parcel tax income and expenditures.
