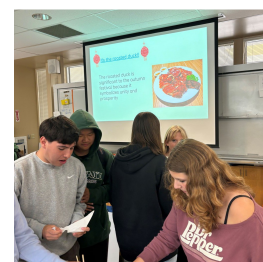

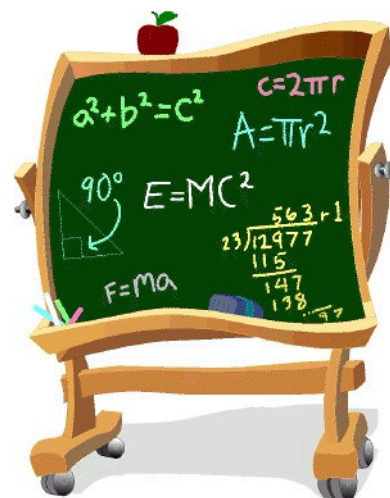




## Math Tutors Needed
