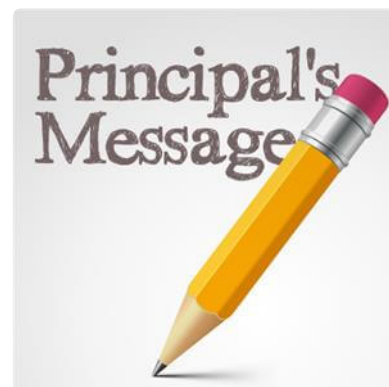

Field Replacement Project

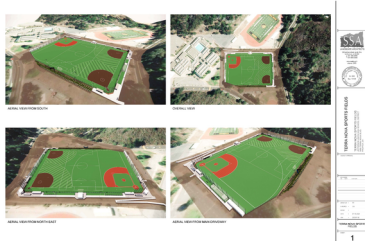
Here the details about the field replacement project, made possible by the Bond Measure Z (2020).

What's Happening:

- New Turf Field: The grass field that housed our baseball field will receive new turf which will help address long-standing drainage issues and combat gopher challenges that have affected the natural grass.

- The area will be reconfigured to hold baseball and softball fields as well as being striped for soccer.
- The infill to the turf blades is sustainable olive pits and cornhusk
- LED Lights: New controlled LED lighting will be installed to improve visibility and extend the usability of our fields for evening activities.
- The lighting is controlled LED lights with pinpoint precision that are focused directly on the field and not on the neighborhood
- New Restrooms: Convenient restrooms will be added directly on the fields to enhance the comfort and accessibility for all visitors and athletes.
- Snack Shack: A new snack shack will be available to provide refreshments during events and games.
- Upper Field: Work is not being completed on the upper field. It is housing the dirt displaced by the construction.

The fields are scheduled for completion by mid-February while the structures may mpleted be shortly after. We appreciate your patience and support as we work to make these much-needed improvements.

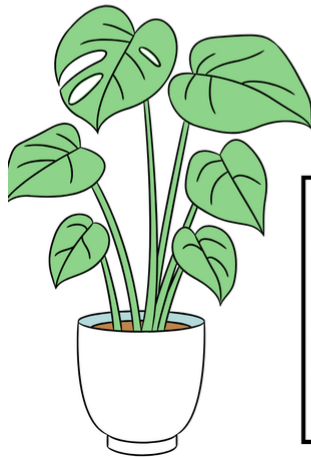
