I hope this message finds you and your family well. As our school year moves forward, I would like to share that the staff and faculty have begun the work involved with completing our WASC accreditation.

WASC stands for the Western Association of Schools and Colleges and it is the accrediting committee for schools, including Terra

Nova. Being WASC accredited validates our school program, our credits/transcripts and provides assurances that we have demonstrated the capacity and commitment to support high-quality student learning. Our last self-study and WASC visit was in fall 2018, with a midterm visit in 2021. The next visit is scheduled for November 2024 and the report is due shortly before then.

The accreditation process centers around writing a self-study report, which essentially asks us to assess our entire school program, analyze student learner data, reflect on student needs and develop new and updated school-wide goals. As a staff, we have utilized several of our collaboration meetings to work on this report, including last Wednesday's all-day staff development day. This process also requires the participation and input from students and families.

I am soliciting interested parents/guardians to join our self-study process. If you would like to join or are curious about what this would entail, please contact me directly. We are also putting the finishing touches on a survey and anticipate it going out this week. Your participation is greatly appreciated. The feedback gathered on this survey and from our volunteers will be included in our report and a significant factor in determining our priority needs as a school community.

I look forward to partnering with you in this important process in order to make Terra Nova an even better place.

2024/25 Financial Aid | FAFSA & CADAA Application | Due April 2nd

Complete your financial aid application as soon as possible for the priority deadline of April 2, 2024. See below to opt-out of submitting a FAFSA/CADAA application.

You (the student) and your parent/guardian will each need to create an account. Please contact your school counselor or stop by the College & Career Center for more information.

FAFSA CA Dream Act

To Opt-Out

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act Application (CADAA) determines a pupil's eligibility for financial aid to assist with a pupil's attendance at a college or career school. California Education Code (CEC) § 51225.7 requires a local educational agency to confirm each 12th grade pupil's completion and submission of a FAFSA or CADAA unless the pupil is determined to be exempt or an opt-out form is completed by a pupil who is a legally emancipated minor, a pupil who is 18 years or older, a legal guardian, or parent, or a local educational agency on a pupil's behalf. This opt-out form permits a pupil to opt out of the completion of a FAFSA or CADAA form.

To opt a pupil out of the Financial Aid Application requirement, please complete and submit this form by April 1, 2024

Submitting a Financial Aid Application Opt-Out Form does not prohibit a pupil from completing and submitting a financial aid application at any time in the future.

- Any other tax forms: 1098s, 1095s, etc.
- Last year's tax return, if available
- Savings and checking account and routing numbers for direct deposit
- Letters/notices from the IRS, if any
