Dear Terra Nova Community,

I would like to address a matter of utmost importance - student behavior. There has been an increase in unkind, discourteous, disrespectful and inappropriate behavior exhibited by students. It ranges from increased littering and garbage throughout campus to sexist, racist, homophobic and transphobic language and slurs.



It saddens me and angers me to have to report this. It should go
without saying that this behavior is completely unacceptable and goes against the values we hold
dear. I want to assure you that we are actively addressing this issue. Consequences for this
behavior, for individuals and groups of students, may include removal from class, suspension, loss
of school privileges, and restorative practices to address the harm their actions caused.

We remain committed to fostering a safe and inclusive community for all students. This school year, we have partnered with Peninsula Conflict Resource Center (PCRC) to deliver an updated conflict resolution curriculum to our Peer Helpers class. We have formed a site equity team that is examining campus issues that contribute to inequity, developing strategies and creating structures needed to sustain a positive and inclusive school community for all students. This work is supported by our district's focus on race, equity and inclusion practices.

I encourage you to have open conversations with your student(s) about the importance of kindness, respect and being an upstander by speaking up, interrupting, being a role model, removing themselves from negative groups/situations and reporting issues to a staff member or through STOPit. By working together, we can create a school community that embodies these values.

We have so many creative clubs here at Terra Nova. Last week the Culinary Club made Thai spring rolls with shrimp and pork to enjoy for lunch.






