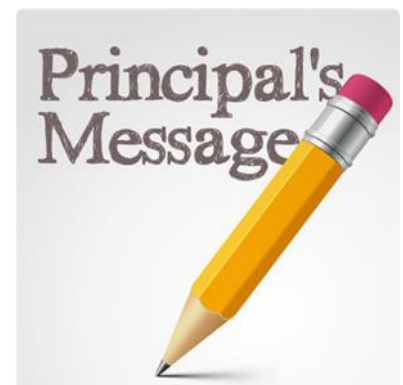

Principal Update

Dear Families,

Starting today, Terra Nova will be using a new anonymous reporting system called STOPit.

[STOPit](#) is an online reporting tool designed to deter and help stop bullying, cyber abuse, and other inappropriate behaviors. Through the STOPit mobile and website, anonymous reports can be made to school administrators, with the goal of creating safer and kinder school communities, both on and offline.



This reporting system allows students and families to:

- Anonymously report concerns through the STOPit App, or website, which are sent to a 24/7 Incident Response Center
- Submit photo or video evidence (App/web only)
- Alert designated administrators to issues and concerns before escalating

No personal information is needed to use STOPit. Both our school and STOPit are committed to protecting the privacy of student data. STOPit is a signatory to the [Student Privacy Pledge](#), spearheaded by the Future of Privacy Forum and the Software & Information Industry Association. You may review STOPit's [Privacy Policy](#) for details, including more information on how anonymous reporting works.

This new system will replace our Tiger Tipline. Today students learned about the system and were given time to download the new app to their phone. Please be sure to check in with your student to ensure they did so and reiterate the importance of being an upstander and reporting issues of concern to us.

QR codes have also been posted around campus to encourage students to download the app. A QR code is included in our newsletter below and accessible on our website.

Tips can also be submitted through a website, <https://appweb.stopitsolutions.com/login>. Users will need to search for and select Terra Nova High School.

SMC Mosquito and Vector Control District Visits APES Classes

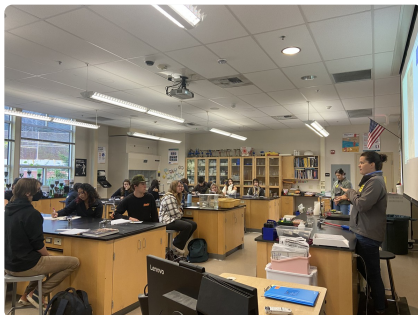
On October 13th, AP Environmental Science classes had a very productive and engaging presentation from Dr. Rachel Curtis-Robles, public health education and outreach officer from the San Mateo County Mosquito and Vector Control District. She talked about the work they do to control mosquitos and other vectors that could transmit diseases in the county. She also talked about how they manage possible mosquito related issues at Sharp Park Golf Course. Students

also learned about what educational background is needed to do the work they do. And students had an opportunity to look at mosquito larva. Dr. Curtis-Robles left a sample of larvae so students can observe for a few weeks the life cycle of mosquitoes.

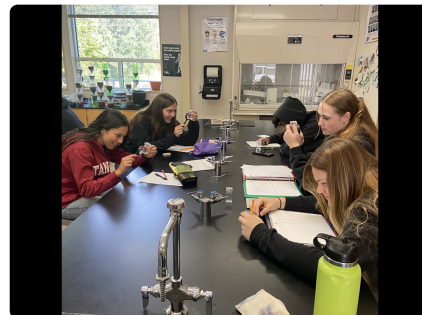
SMCMVCD runs a community education program and they are happy to give presentations not only to schools but other groups in the county for free.
