PSAT Offered for Juniors

Jefferson Union High School District will administer the PSAT/NMSQT in a digital format at no cost for interested 11th grade students . The test will take place during the week of October 23-27 at Terra Nova High School. The exact date is to be determined.

The PSAT/NMSQT is optional and it offers students the opportunity to qualify for scholarships that can help pay for

college. Additionally, it serves as a practice for the SAT. However, please note that since the 2020-21 academic year, numerous higher education institutions have embraced a "test blind/test optional" policy. This policy dictates that any SAT (or ACT) scores submitted by students will not be factored into the decision-making process for admissions or scholarships. Under this policy, colleges and universities are not requiring SAT (ACT) scores for admissions.




