

Athletes Compete at the Quicksilver Invitational with Stellar Results

Congratulations to the following track and field athletes who competed at the Quicksilver Invitational at Leland High School on Saturday, April 1:

- Tyler Rosen earned a season record in the 100-meter dash; and won a medal while securing a personal record in the 400-meter dash.
- Lillet Baumbach made a season record in the 100-meter dash while placing first in her heat; and won a medal in the 400-meter dash.
- Calvin Chan came through with an impressive personal record of 5:35 in the 1600-meter race.
- Sofia Arnest earned first place in both of her heats for the 100-meter and 200-meter dashes. And in both races she achieved new personal records.
- Madison Lee placed first in her heat for the 200-meter dash, and achieved a new personal record for both the 100 and 200.
- Rynne Reynolds came in with a strong 11th place in the top 15 for the 1600-meter race
- Naia Wolfe placed 2nd in her heat in the 200-meter dash and simultaneously earning a new personal record.
- Emilia Ellison rose to a new personal record in the 1600 race, and placed a strong 13th overall in the top 15
- Abigail Eastham-Anderson took home 3 medals: 6th place overall in the 200-meter dash while achieving a new season record; 3rd place overall, along with a new season record in the 100-meter dash; and 1st place overall in the 100-meter hurdles.
- Julia Eliares placed 7th overall, earning a spot in the top 15 for shot put
- Finally, our JV Girls 4 by 400-meter relay team--Sofia Arnest, Madison Lee, Naia Wolfe, and Lillet Baumbach--swept their competition and won first place in their heat, and carried away four more medals for Terra Nova.

Asian Club will launch its 16th Step Up Flip Flops Drive on **Tuesday, April 18, 2023**. This is a campaign we started 16 years ago to collect flip flops for students ages 6-12 in remote areas in the Philippines who walk barefoot to school.

For many years now, we have partnered with a foundation called Project Malasakit to distribute the flip flops to a group in most need of them. Project Malasakit is headed by Kara David, a good friend and one of the top broadcast journalists in the Philippines. The flipflops are distributed to children from an indigenous group called Aytas who were displaced by the eruption of Mt. Pinatubo in the 90s. The flip flops are part of a care package that includes school supplies and other essentials. Attached is a collage of pictures taken when the kids received their care package in 2021.






