#### 2023/24 Course Selection Process

In the coming weeks, the Counseling Department will begin the course selection process for the 23-24 school year. We would like to inform you of the process and next steps for your student.

Counselors will meet with students during their Freshman Seminar, Health or Social Science class. At the start of each class period, there will be a short presentation outlining the process for students



and then each student will meet with their counselor individually to review their transcripts and select their courses for next year. Students will be given a worksheet to select their classes and counselors will enter their course requests into our system. After meeting with their counselor, students will then be instructed to take their course selection worksheets home, discuss their choices with their parent/guardian, and receive a parent/guardian signature on the worksheet. Once the worksheet has been signed by both student and parent/guardian, the student will be responsible for turning their form into the counseling office.

**Important note:** If students make any changes to their course selection sheet after speaking with their counselor, they must check the box at the top of their course selection form that states: "Check this box if you updated this course request form after meeting with your counselor".

Every effort is made to give students their first elective choice. If a lower ranked elective selection is scheduled, students will not be allowed to make an elective change. Schedules are only changed for academic misplacement or computer error. Teacher requests and class period requests are not allowed.

## **FAFSA/CADAA Financial Aid Information**

*The deadline to submit your financial aid application is approaching soon on March 2nd. If you have not yet done so, please submit your applications ASAP.*

The Terra Nova Counseling Department would like to share important information regarding how your student can receive free money to pay for college!

### **What is the FAFSA?**

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is an application to determine eligibility for federal student aid. The FAFSA must be completed in order to apply and be considered for federal student aid such as federal grants, work-study, and loans.

Many states and colleges use FAFSA information to determine eligibility for state and school aid. Completing and submitting the FAFSA is free.

### **What is CADAA?**

The California Dream Act Application (CADAA) allows students interested in attending eligible California Colleges, Universities, and Career Education Programs to apply for state financial aid.


